

**RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
HEARTBEAT AT 22**

Jan Lupia and Art Lupia certify that:

1. They are the president and secretary, respectively, of HEARTBEAT AT 22, a California nonprofit public benefit corporation.
2. The Articles of Incorporation of this corporation are amended and restated to read as follows:

I

The name of this corporation is **MAMA'S HOUSE MINISTRIES**.

II

This corporation is a nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes.

III

The specific purposes of this corporation are to provide education about abortion, to facilitate restoration for those who have been affected by abortion, to provide adoption assistance, and to establish safe, nurturing homes for women in crises pregnancies.

IV

This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3), or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

V

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and this corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.

VI

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof, or to the benefit of any private person.




Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3), or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

3. The foregoing amendment and restatement of the Articles of Incorporation has been duly approved by the board of directors.
4. The corporation has no members.

We further declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the matters set forth in this certificate are true and correct of our own knowledge.


Dear Applicant:
