

What is it?



DFree Pro is a non-invasive wearable device that monitors the bladder and sends notifications when it's time to go to the bathroom.

DFree Pro is designed for use by hospitals, skilled nursing and senior care communities to provide residents and patients with timely toileting care.

Avoiding accidents and getting to the bathroom on time is a constant concern for all. DFree Pro sends the caregiver advance notifications so he/she can help a patient/resident get to the bathroom in ample time. DFree Pro also supports self-toileting by predicting when to go to the bathroom.

How it works

DFree Pro monitors the patient's/resident's bladder, predicts when the bladder is full, and sends alerts to go to the bathroom.





Safe and non-invasive

DFree Pro uses a harmless and non-invasive ultrasound sensor to monitor the bladder.

Easy to use


Simply secure the ultrasound sensor using an adhesive tape to the lower abdomen.



All the data in one place

DFree Pro app tracks changes in bladder, records urination timings, and sends alerts for bathroom visits.

Track multiple patients

DFree Pro app can track multiple patients/ residents on a single screen so you know which patients need toileting care.



Receive notifications

Caregiver will receive timely notifications when the patient/resident needs to use the bathroom.



Detailed analysis

DFree Pro website can show patients'/residents' urination timings at a glance using a chart.



Remote monitoring

Access patient/resident data remotely via Internet enabled devices including smartphones, tablets and laptops.
