Wheels at Wanaka, is proudly presented by Three Parks, Wanaka. A biennial event, alternating every odd Easter with Warbirds Over Wanaka International Air Show. <u>Wheels at Wanaka</u> is an all vehicle, all machinery "history–in–motion" vintage fair – including steam engines, tractors and farming heritage, cars of all sorts, motor–bikes, trucks, earthmovers and heavy machinery.

Buzzing with energy, Wheels at Wanaka is huge! With over 50 acres of entertainment, with tractor/truck pulling and Enduro X dirt bike competitions, ATV and electric rally car demos, an earthmoving extravaganza and a non-stop parade ground programme! If it's got wheels or tracks it will be on show it this Easter.

Wheels at Wanaka's inaugural 2019 event attracted 12,000 visitors over two days. In 2021, we achieved 25,000 attendees by adding an extra earthmoving practice day, Enduro X motorbike races and Polaris ATV demonstrations. We expect up to 30,000 people for 2023. 75% of attendees travelled more than two hours to attend the show.

BOOKING PROCESS

- Trade, food, coffee and market stalls are to be booked and paid for <u>online</u>.
- Book your trade site online and SAVE up to 25%! <u>Book here.</u> All manual site bookings will incur a \$100 admin fee.

- Sites booked and paid for, in full online will be automatically confirmed. Excluding sites requiring liquor licences
- Exhibitors booking online but deferring payment by invoice sites will be confirmed by 30 September 2022 (subject to payment before 30 December 2022).
- Trade stand passes will only be emailed once full payment has been made.
- 2021s pre-booked exhibitors will be confirmed upon receipt of 2023s online booking form (subject to payment before 30 December 2022).
- Earthmoving practice day food and coffee sites will be available by invite only please indicate your interest on the form. Site fees may apply.
- Note: only the earthmoving zone will be open to the public on Good Friday 7 April between 9am – 4.30pm. The main show zone being the parade ground, markets and kids zone, motorbikes and ATVs, tractor, trucks and car zones will be in setup mode. Only exhibiting enthusiasts will have access to the main show zone.

- Manual forms received via email or in the post will be subject to a \$100 administration fee.

SITE PRICING

- Site allocations will be organised by powered or non-powered. Please make sure you indicate if you require power.
- Upper Clutha community stalls are welcome to email an expression of interest for a site free of charge via <u>info@wheelsatwanaka.co.nz</u>
- Additional tickets for stall helpers outside of your site allowance = \$20 per adult and \$5 per youth (12 18 years). Ticket prices include GST. Kids 12 years and under enter for free.

LICENSED BARS

Wheels at Wanaka will be the licensee and operate all bars in 2023. However if you wish to conduct tastings and sell takeaway bottles of alcohol e.g. gin, whiskey and wine, you must contact QLDC to gain your off license and provide us with your number.

PRICE INCLUDES

- Inclusion in the trade exhibitors lists on Wheels at Wanaka's website and official site map/programme (cut-off 30 January 2023)
- All sites are outdoors and are available from 3x3m.
- Ground surface: dry grass.
- Site security for patrolling grounds during show hours, overnight and including set up and pack down days – from Thursday 6 April until Sunday 9 April 8pm.
- St Johns and the fire brigade will be available Friday, Saturday and Sunday 8am – 5pm.
- All prices are plus GST
- It is the exhibitor's responsibility to provide all signage, equipment and marquee.
- Every member of your team must have a ticket to enter Wheels at Wanaka during the show. Exhibitors are supplied with two x three-day passes allowing two-people entry for three days (or as per your site size).
- It is possible for a two-day pass to be swapped for two one day passes on application.
- Please be aware of our general terms and conditions
- Additional tickets for stall helpers outside of your site allocation allowance may be purchased for \$15 per adult and \$5 per youth (13–18 years), kids 12 years and under enter for free, and covers the three days including GST. These can be purchased online via <u>Humanitix</u>.

POWER

Power is subject to availability and will be charged out separately and directly to each exhibitor. Please indicate on the application if you require power, so that we can allocate you the appropriate powered stand.

We do not encourage the use of personal generators but if you do bring your own, it must be of the silent-type and fully compliant with ANZ standards.

Note: exhibitors will be monitored during the event to ascertain their power usage. Any exhibitor exceeding their level may trip the circuit breaker and will be charged a penalty in addition to the fee. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to arrange all electrical equipment on their site.

All electrical equipment on site must comply with Australian/New Zealand standard 3002:2002.

SITE PLAN & ALLOCATION

The site plan is subject to change. The allocation of your site within the site plan will be arranged by the Wheels at Wanaka organising committee – it is their final decision as to where your market stall will be allocated. We will do our best to arrange stalls according to their content, theme and subject matter. We will endeavour to discuss placement with you where possible.

VEHICLE MOVEMENTS DURING SHOW TIME

Any vehicles that are part of a trade stall or exhibition must be in place prior to 8.30am on Saturday 8 April. Once in situ, these vehicles will not be allowed to move until after 4pm on Sunday 9 April. Any vehicles, that are not part of a trade stall or exhibition, may be on site prior to the start of the show, and will be admitted between 6am and 8.30am on Saturday and Sunday. From 9am all vehicles must be in their allocated parking and will not be allowed to move until after 4pm each day.

Restocking is allowed from 4.30pm to 7.30pm on Saturday evening.

PARKING

Special exhibitor parking and trailer parking will be available within a reserved section of the event site, you will be guided by signage and by our volunteers.

Each exhibitor will be provided with one trade car parking pass.

RECYCLING & WASTE MANAGEMENT

We encourage recycling and will have Wanaka Wastebusters onsite to assist with our waste systems – please contact Wanaka Wastebusters 03 443 8606 for guidance on how to sort for rubbish your recycling.

Please bring your own rubbish bins – we plan to have a transfer skip will be onsite for exhibitors.

We encourage the use of recycled paper packaging and non-bleached napkins over plastic where possible.

HIAB & TELEHANDLER BOOKINGS

INSURANCES, DAMAGES AND CLAIMS

- Exhibitors are advised to arrange personal insurance cover for their own property.
- All exhibitors should have public liability insurance for an amount not less than \$2,000. Proof of this cover or an affidavit is to be produced, if requested. The Wheels at Wanaka Charitable Trust will not be responsible for any claim.
- The Wheels at Wanaka Charitable Trust will take all care but will not be responsible for any losses or damage incurred at this event.

SIGNAGE

- No exhibit shall erect scaffolding above the height of 2m for the purpose of signage. Wheels at Wanaka reserves the right to remove any signage they deem inappropriate.
- No signage shall be erected outside of their measured site.
- No signage shall be erected on the security fencing.

CANCELLATIONS

- You will receive written notification should Wheels at Wanaka be postponed or cancelled.
- The Wheels at Wanaka Charitable Trust shall not be liable to the exhibitor for any compensation whatsoever as a result of the cancellation or postponement of the event.
- If the event is abandoned or postponed due to any reason beyond the control of the Wheels at Wanaka Charitable Trust, the Trust is under no obligation to refund in whole or in part any payments made by trade, market, food and community stall holders or exhibitors.

EXHIBITOR CANCELLATION

If an exhibitor should cancel the contract or terminate a site booking:

- on or after 30 December 2022 Wheels at Wanaka will retain all monies received
- prior to 30 December 2022, any refund shall be at the Wheels at Wanaka Trust and organising committees discretion, not withstanding a nonrefundable \$100+GST administration fee.

The Wheels at Wanaka Charitable Trust and organising committees have the right to cancel this agreement and to retain any monies paid in relation to this contract if the exhibitor:

- infringes any of the exhibiting conditions, and/or
- does not occupy the site during the full period of the show to which this contract applies and/or
- does not complete site set up by 9am on Saturday 8 April 2023.


