A limited number of camp sites are available to exhibitors, volunteers and trade stall holders (only). Failure to adhere to our camping rules will result in being asked to leave.









Main Food, Trade and Market Map







A HAZARD is something that has the potential to harm you

RISK is the likelihood of a hazard causing harm

HOW TO KEEP YOURSELF AND OTHERS SAFE AT THE EVENT

General Health & Safety Requirements



COVID-19

- Not come to the event if testing positive or feeling unwell
- Wash hands regularly with soap and water
- Use hand sanitiser
- Report any symptoms to the St John Medical Team
- Advised to undertake a RAT prior to starting work, These are also available free on site

Mobility Options

Jump on board the free shuttles looping the site (see site map for shuttle stop locations)

or bring your own mountain bike, ebike or mobility scooter



Single seat mobility scooters and bikes are welcome. 5kmph speed limit, helmets required, charging station available.



Dual seat transport options including golf carts, ATVs quad bikes and motorbikes are not permitted. Sorry, dogs are also not permitted anywhere on site.






Traffic and People Movement

- Follow the posted speed limit
- Use a safety spotter (e.g. reversing)
- Follow traffic plan & road rules
- Follow marshal instructions
- Drive to the conditions





Near Large Plant/Equipment

- Keep clear of swing areas
- Do not approach working machinery





Operating Motorised Equipment


- Only qualified driver operators 16 years and older to operate any equipment
- Be vigilant with reversing vehicles (use a spotter)
- Clean up leakage spills and advise person in charge of your section
- DO NOT use cellphone while operating motorised vehicles
- Follow Marshal instructions





Electrical Safety

- Electrical work must be carried out by a registered electrician.
- Check it with Ottapower, onsite, if in doubt.
- All items that plug into mains electricity must have:







Cylinders Under Pressure

When using cylinders under pressure (e.g., LPG):

- Make sure they are within current test date
- You have the correct connections
- If it is flammable gas (e.g., LPG):
 - Manage the risk of uncontrolled ignition
 - Have the correct Fire Extinguisher







Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) includes

- Hi-Viz with reflective stripes is required
 - On site during Pack-in/Pack out
 - Operating or working around machinery
- Covered footwear is required when working on site
- Use of other PPE feet, hearing, eyes, hand, as required (depending on the risk)
- Ear protection is recommended for prolonged time viewing or operating within the Earthmoving demonstration pit.



Pollution

Wheels at Wanaka loves making sure that the environment is safe for everyone:

- Dispose of any garbage safely
- Isolate & report any hazardous spills
- Use chemicals safely
- Cover stormwater drains if needed







Drugs and Alcohol



Trade Exhibitors are **<u>NOT</u>** allowed to:

- Consume illegal substances on site; or
- Operate a vehicle or equipment whilst under the influence of alcohol

Trade Exhibitors **<u>ARE</u>** allowed to:


Consume alcohol after they have finished work

Reporting Stuff

To help us fix things, we need you to report A.S.A.P.

- Near Misses ("phew, that was close!")
- Things that could hurt someone – risks/hazards
- Injuries / incidents
- Broken stuff
- Pollution







Managing and Reporting Incidents

- Make sure the area is safe
- Check if First Aid is required
- Contact a person in a blue vest

- Report on the Google Form as demonstrated

For a Fire



- If the Fire is very small, and it is safe to do so e.g., small rubbish bin) use a Fire Extinguisher.
- 12x Extinguishers will be in key locations around the site
- Warn others in the area
- If it is serious
- Contact Event Management, or Call 111 and state:
 - Type of Fire and location
 - Have someone wait for and direct Fire and Emergency personnel (who are on site during the event)
- Site Address is 135 Ballantyne Road, Wanaka





For Civil Emergencies

- For Emergencies follow Event Management instructions
- Civil Emergencies could include:
 - Tornado
 - Cyclone
 - Storm Event
 - Earthquake
 - Flooding





Equipment/Machinery Emergency

STOP!

- Make sure equipment/ machinery is safe
- Get off the equipment/ machinery
- Stand back in a safe area
- Wait for assistance from person in <u>BLUE</u>vest



- DO NOT start or operate the equipment/machinery until the OK is given
- Assist with keeping public at a safe distance





For First Aid

- Each Contractor/Supplier should have their own First Aid Kit and First Aiders for Pack-in/Pack-out
- St John is on location at 3 sites during the event





Medical Emergency

- During the event St John are on site if there is an injury or medical emergency
- Contact Event Management or Call 111
- State:
 - Type of Injury or medical condition
 - Have someone wait for and direct St John personnel
- Site Address is 135 Ballantyne Road, Wanaka







For a Public Disturbance

- Security and Police are on site for any public disturbances
- Contact Event Management, Security or the Police if you have any concerns
- Ensure yours own and your team's safety first







For Evacuations

- When the alarm horns or hooters sounds, evacuate immediately to an assembly point
- Report to an assigned evacuation assembly point and wait for further instructions
- Do not re-enter areas in the event site until directed to do so by event management
