Nouns

Names of people, objects or things. E.g. House, Cow, Florence, Car and Bike.

Verbs

A doing word. Verbs are words that name an action. E.g. Run, Jump, Dance, Learn and Think.

Prepositions

Prepositions often tell you where something is or when something happened. E.g. Under, Behind, Near, Since and Before.

Adjectives

A word that describes a Noun. E.g. Happy, Rusty, Bitter, Breezy, Noisy and Gigantic.

Conjunctions

Words which connect words, phrases, clauses or sentences are called conjunctions. E.g. For, And, Nor, But, Or, Since, Because and Furthermore.

Adverbs

An adverb is a word which modifies a verb, which means that it tells you how, when, where or why something is being done. E.g. Loudly, Nastily, Slowly, Gracefully, Thoughtfully and Energetically.

Pronouns

A pronoun is a word used to replace a noun. E.g. He, She, They, Mine and We.

Determiners

A determiner is a word that goes before a noun and identifies the noun in further detail. E.g. A, The, These, Her, Some, Every, Three and Whose.
