## Essentials

- water, 1 gal per person per day, for 5-7 days
- non-perishable food, for 5-7 days
- paper plates, plastic cups, disposable utensils
- can opener, non-electric
- battery-operated or hand-crank radio
- flashlights
- extra batteries
- whistle
- cell phone chargers
- matches or lighter

## Sanitary Supplies

- disinfectant
- toilet paper, paper towels
- feminine supplies
- sanitary wipes
- deodorant
- soap
- extra water for sanitation
- bleach
- trash bags
- scissors & tweezers
- sewing needle
- latex gloves
- antiseptic

## First-Aid & Medical Supplies

- medications, including prescription drugs, insulin, etc.
- life-threatening allergy relief, e.g. epinephrine, steroids
- other allergy relief, e.g. Benadryl, antihistamines, topical, nasal sprays
- eye glasses or contacts & contacts solution
- thermometer
- aspirin
- anti-diarrheal medicine
- antibiotic ointment
- bandages
- sunscreen
- sunglasses
- bug repellent

## Documents & Money (in a waterproof bag)

- important telephone numbers, printed or written on paper
- cash or traveler's checks
- bank account numbers
- credit card records
- family records
- copy of will, deeds, stocks, bonds, insurance policies
- copy of passports, social sec. cards, immunization records
- detailed photos of your house (interior & exterior) & inventory of personal property

## Baby Supplies

- formula
- powdered milk & specialty food
- diapers & wipes
- baby medications, including fever reducers
- bottles, sippy cups
- blankets
- toys

## Pet Supplies

- pet food
- water
- medications
- leash, harness, carrier, or cage
- records of vaccinations

## Other

- rain boots
- rain coats
- blankets
- fire extinguisher
- books & games
- full gas tank in all cars
