

2020 — Spring Update



It's been a difficult few months, but the mission continues! Throughout the COVID-19 crisis, the Mission has remained open, with all essential services available. Please know that we are continuing to take extra precautions, ensuring that masks are worn at all times and surfaces are disinfected regularly. A work structure has been developed between the Mission, the Grand Forks Health Department, Spectra Health, and Altru Health System to deal with the current crisis and safely handle any individuals displaying COVID-19 symptoms. In the meantime, clients still have access to food, shelter, clothing, hygiene products, shower/laundry facilities, and the Mission's advocacy team.

With your support, we are also working hard to meet the increased demand for food assistance. Community meals, food boxes, the Mobile Food Pantry, and the Backpack Program are still going, with necessary precautions in place. As we continue to navigate these uncertain times, we pray that you and your loved ones are safe and healthy. From the bottom of our hearts, thank you for supporting the Mission and the community in a time of need. We are all in this together.

The Work Continues!

We are excited to say that despite the unique challenges of 2020, clients are still moving into their own homes! After basic client safety, housing remains our top priority. In fact, helping a client get housed may be the best thing we can do for their well-being at this time. We are encouraged by the continued efforts of our advocacy team, local landlords & agencies, and clients themselves. Together, we are finding a sensible and safe path forward for each individual at the Mission.
