- 1. Learning First—Hear of the findings from the world's largest global survey of learning.
- **2. Democratisation of Learning**—Recognize the power of feedback to empower children to have voice in their own learning.
- **3. Social Emotional Learning (SEL)**—Explore the power of high collective efficacy to lift those struggling with self-efficacy.
- **4. Learning Strategies**—Learn of the 450 different learning strategies that John Hattie and his team have identified, noting that most learners use between 1 and 3 for most tasks.
- 5. Embracing Errors and Mistakes—Understand that mistakes lie at the hinge point of learning and how to help children move beyond errors to genuine learning.
