Opponents

It seems guite natural for God's people to have opponents. This seemed always to be the case for the prophets under the old covenant, for Jesus, the apostles, and the early Church. The New Testament emphasis seems not to fall on the tragedy of having opponents, but on how we respond to them. Many years ago, I remember being attacked forcefully by a Christian brother with whom I was in partnership on a mission trip. This scripture immediately sprung to mind, "And the Lord's servant must not be quarrelsome but kind to everyone, able to teach, patiently enduring evil, 25 correcting his opponents with gentleness." As I sensed the Lord speaking to me I responded with humility to his assailment, and everything quickly calmed down. This seems to be the hope motivating the original exhortation, "God may perhaps grant them (the opponents) repentance leading to a knowledge of the truth, 26 and they may come to their senses and escape from the snare of the devil, after being captured by him to do his will." (2 Tim 2:24-26). If Jesus was publicly and viciously assaulted in order that "When he was reviled, he did not revile in return; when he suffered, he did not threaten, but continued entrusting himself to him who judges justly." (1 Pet 2:23), this must be our direction in life too. It seems practically impossible to forgive in advance an action intentionally done at some later time to harm us. As Jesus needed to endure the full brutality of the cross before he could release forgiveness to his persecutors (Luke 23:34), so it must be with us. The saving power of the Holy Spirit needs to be activated by faith at the very moment we are sinned against. This is the wisdom and glory of God. Why am I writing this? Because today we are starting a series on 2 Peter, a little book which magnifies the stature of our Lord Jesus Christ in the context of the attacks by false prophets. Today the Anglican Church in Perth is being misled by a group who claim some religious, even spiritual, authority, to teach the people of God new divine truths. Unfortunately, their claims will have to be exposed as false, dangerous, and misleading. Not to expose such dangerous teachings would be unloving, not only to the people of God but to the perpetrators. Please pray for our series.

MISSION PROJECT UPDATE Information for your Prayers

Jesus Ministries Myanmar

Whilst there have been about 20, 000 deaths from COVID, and the nation being under severe martial, Nagaland in the remote northwest of the country is relatively peaceful. The Nagas are a non-Burmese tribal group, once animists and headhunters, the vast majority are now Christians converts. However, well financed Buddhist groups have been using access to education to convert poor families. With access to cheap heroin, cannabis and methamphetamines, addiction amongst young people has become a major problem. Our friends in *Jesus Ministries Myanmar* have launched a gospel-based vision (Matt 16:18) and mission (Luke 4:19) in the town of Khamti called: *Powerful Youth Centre*. A block of land has been purchased with help from Australia and there are presently 5 girls and 12 boys in the programme. Current needs include onsite security and construction costs to assist in the ongoing care of these restless young people.
