Jesus, again and again

An old Tabor College joke was "The answer to all of John Yates' questions is...." The correct answer is a five-letter word starting with "J" and ending with "s". This doesn't make me a member of the "Jesus Only" movement, who see God appearing in three phases (called modalism), sometimes choosing to reveal himself as Father, sometimes as Son, sometimes as Spirit. (I have never been quite clear on how they deal with the baptism of Christ when he hears from the Father and receives the Spirit in the form of a dove!) I am not, and never will be, what they call a Christomonistic preacher. As if Jesus was all that mattered. I trust last week you heard the Spirit preaching about the Father through my lifting up the name of Jesus? My theological stance is summarised in what John says of the Lord, "All things were made through him, and without him was not any thing made that was made." (John 1:3), magnified by the apostle Paul, "all things were created through him and for him" (Col 1:16) and echoed in Hebrews, "in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world. 3 He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power." (1:2-3). Jesus is the centre and circumference of all of God's purposes for his creation. The only plan of God unfolded for us in scripture is the "making known to us the mystery of his will, according to his purpose, which he set forth in Christ 10 as a plan for the fullness of time, to unite all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth." (Eph 1:9-10). In focussing on the life and teachings of Christ as our Lord, we see exactly who our Creator is, and receive the fulness of the revelation of his plan for us as humans created, not in some general or vague "image of God", but in the likeness of his most beloved Son. Jesus is "the image of the invisible God" (Col 1:15). Why look beyond Christ when all that the Father has ever wanted to make known about himself is present in the Lord of love?

God has worked with those persons who had the endurance to travel miles and miles, just to minister to one person... God has worked with hundreds of people who have sat in offices typing, filing, paying bills, producing prayer notes or cutting out stamps... God has worked in the people who have dropped their pennies and sixpences and fifty cent coins into the money boxes... God has worked in the people who decided they may have retired from paid work, but not from ministry, and take to the roads in their vans... God has worked in the people who wrote Sunday School lessons, and ran youth groups with a handful of kids in a little church hall...'
