Our Father in Heaven

Who is the God we pray to?

In our reading from Jesus' Sermon on the Mount today, we get to what we now know of as the 'Lord's Prayer'. And one of Jesus' key points is that the 'what' (content) of prayer flows directly from the 'who' it is are praying to.

Jesus tells his disciples they do *not* need to "babble" on like the pagans, "for they think they will be heard because of their many words" (Mt 6:7). The pagan 'gods' may be ignorant or unwilling to answer, and so needed to be pestered in prayer. But not so the God revealed in the Bible, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! "Your Father knows what you need before you ask him." (v.8). And so Jesus teaches his disciples to pray a simple prayer, which begins with the confidence of that radical truth: "Our Father in heaven" (v.9).

The Lord's Prayer is so well known. And yet just this first line is revolutionary. In many ways, everything else in the Lord's Prayer simply flows from it. For once we know God as our good and glorious Father, it makes all the sense in the world that we (first) ask for His name to be honoured, His kingdom to come and His will to be done, and (second) ask Him for provision, pardon and protection.

Do you know God to be your Father in heaven? By Christ's immeasurable grace, we can be forgiven and reconciled to God and included in his family, brought into relationship with him no less than as his loved sons and daughters. And who we pray to shapes what we pray.

Let me quote from Anglican theologian JI Packer: "The Lord's Prayer is in family terms: Jesus teaches us to invoke God as our Father, just as he himself did... If we are to pray and live as we should, we must grasp the implications of God's gracious fatherhood... as the Prayer Book says, he is "always more ready to hear than we to pray," and is "wont to give more than either we desire or deserve."... To know this truth of God's fatherly love to us gives boundless confidence not merely for praying, but for all our living..." (JI Packer, *Growing in Christ* p.163).

Recently Barnabas has been supplying aid to Christians displaced by Jihadi attacks in Cameroon, assisting impoverished believers in Lebanon, funding repairs for a Christian hospital in Pakistan and supplying food to Middle Eastern refugees in Jordan.

Aid keeps arriving in Ukraine, whilst relevant skills are provided for grassroots church leaders in South Sudan. Flooding in West Africa and internal displacement in Myanmar continues to terrorise multitudes. Food is being sent to drought affected Namibia, whilst ISIS attacks in Congo target believers.

Anti-conversion legislation is spreading across India despite supposed constitutional religious liberties. The list could be extended indefinitely, such as troubles in Mozambique, Iran, Central Asia, Nigeria, Burkina Faso, Algeria... Please pray for this ministry and for our persecuted brothers and sisters across the globe in their ever acute needs.
