# Seek and You Will Find

Dear brothers and sisters,

Do you pray? Are we a church who prays?

Perhaps one reason we might be slow to pray, is because of our view of God. Perhaps we think God is uninterested, distant, unable, or unwilling? Perhaps we feel that approaching God would be like an ordinary citizen of a country trying to get an audience with the prime minister or president? Or a junior employee trying to get an answer from the bigshot CEO? But what if approaching God is in fact like a loved child approaching their father or mother?

In our passage today, Jesus encourages his disciples that God is our loving heavenly Father who delights to give good gifts to his children: "Which of you, if your son asks for bread, will give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will give him a snake? If you, then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give good gifts to those who ask him!" (Matthew 7:9-11)

Through Jesus, who died for all our evil, we can be adopted by God, and know our holy righteous Creator and Judge as our loving Father. And so, if even human parents, with their sin and selfishness (or is that just me?), give good gifts to their children, how much more will God, our perfectly good and loving and generous Father in heaven, give good gifts to those who ask him? As one of the Anglican Prayer Book's collects puts it, "you are always more ready to answer than we are to pray, and to give more than we either desire or deserve". *That* is our Father in Heaven.

So, will we confidently ask Him to give us 'good gifts'?

Will we ask God to give us the good gift of a character which reflects his righteousness, his purity, his love?

Will we ask God to give us the good gift of forgiveness of our sins and acceptance into his kingdom?

Will we ask God to give us the best gift of himself, that he would be with us by his Spirit, now and for all eternity?

If we do, Jesus promises we can have the confidence, "Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you." (Matthew 7:7)
