Gathering to Pray

Dear brothers and sisters.

Of the many astounding privileges of the Christian life, one is that we can speak with God, knowing God will hear and answer our prayers in accordance with his good will. "The Spirit you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again: rather, the Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship. And by him we cry, 'Abba, Father." (Romans 8:15).

Jesus called God the Father 'Abba'. And the wonder is that, through Jesus, we can not only be forgiven but adopted as God's accepted, beloved children. Without Christ, we had genuine reason to fear the condemnation and wrath of God which we deserved for our sin, but Christ has died for sin and gives us his Spirit through whom we now cry to God, as Jesus did, 'Father'. And that means we can bring all our anxieties, requests, desires, confessions and thanks to God our Heavenly Father. knowing that God is absolutely committed to listening and answering as is for our best.

But not only can we confidently pray; we must pray. We are wholly dependent on God. We need God to be at work in us, personally and corporately, by his Spirit. "Not by might, nor by power, but by my Spirit,' says the LORD Almighty." (Zech 4:6). We might plant and water, but it is only "God who makes things grow" (1 Cor 3:7). So, in us and our communities, for life and help and transformation, we can pray, and we must pray.

And with that in mind, we want to give two upcoming opportunities to join as a church family in prayer:

Prayer for Healing – Sunday 20th August, immediately after our 9:30am service. This will be an opportunity for us to request and receive prayer, for ourselves and others, for healing in body, mind and soul.

Prayer for Ministry and Mission – Saturday 2nd September 3-5pm. A time to pray for the Lord's guidance, provision, empowering and blessing for our ministries and mission, with an opportunity to share ideas, followed by a light meal.

May God grow us as people of prayer. Through the Son, by the Spirit, let us pray to the Father, who "is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine".
