# ST MARK'S BASSENDEAN

Dear brothers and sisters,

Welcome to St Mark's today, especially if you are here for Alex's baptism, it is wonderful to have you with us. In this Pewsheet Message I'd like to say something about the Voice, and then about our passage for today.

By the time we meet next Sunday, we will have had the Referendum on the Voice to Parliament. I do not believe it is in my role to tell you *what* to vote, but, as John did a couple of weeks ago, I do wish to encourage you *how* to vote: please vote in prayerful dependence on God, seeking to honour God and reflect his ways, and in a spirit of humility and kindness to others who may vote differently. The issues are complex, yet as we prepare to vote, as Christians we have a responsibility and privilege to follow (not political parties but) Jesus, in othercentred love to all others in our nation. May we, as Paul says, "whether you eat or drink [or, in this case, vote yes or no!] or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God" (1 Cor 10:31).

Our Gospel passage today reminds us that the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ delights to show extravagant generosity to the underserving. Jesus tells a parable to illustrate: imagine a farmer goes out to hire casual workers to work in his vineyard: some work all day, some 9 hrs, some 6, some 3, and some only 1 hour. And then the shock: the farmer gives everyone the exact same pay! How would that make you feel? Those hired first grumble, but the farmer responds that he has not underpaid them (they get exactly what they agreed to work for). "Or are you envious because I am generous?" (Matt 20:15). That's the wonderful thing about God: he is crazy-it-doesn't-make-sense generous to the undeserving. He offers the exact same gift of forgiveness of sin and eternal life with him to everyone. Whoever we are, whatever our lives have looked like so far, if we come to him through Jesus, he won't give us less, but far more than we deserve. As we sing:

"Amazing grace, how sweet the sound, that saved a wretch like me, I once was lost, but now am found, was blind but now I see."

Our prayer for Alex as he is baptised today, and for all of us, is that we may know and rejoice in this undeserved grace of God given us in Jesus.
