# ST MARK'S BASSENDEAN

Discovering and demonstrating Jesus' love in Bassendean and beyond.

Dear brothers and sisters,

What is the great Australian dream? Our Lottery ads show pictures of the 'good life', like lying in a sunlounger by the pool, simply clicking your fingers for your cocktail to be replenished. It's an image of comfort, ease, and power. And even if we can't win the Lottery, most of us wouldn't mind the idea of early retirement, an upgraded house, and a personal butler! But is that what greatness really is?

In our gospel reading today, Jesus says four simple and revolutionary words: "not so with you" (Matthew 20:26). His disciples are to pursue a different greatness. James, John and their mother have asked Jesus for the top spots in his kingdom. And the other 10 disciples are indignant – because they didn't get in first! But Jesus says that kind of ambition is worldly: the Gentiles "lord it over" one another (v.25). But "not so with you". "Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, and whoever wants to be first must be your slave" (v.26). Jesus has a different measure of greatness: service. In his kingdom, the way up is the way down. Not self-seeking, but self-sacrifice.

And that is what he did for us: "Just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many" (v.28). As we've read through Matthew's gospel, we've seen Jesus revealed as the majestic King of God's kingdom, with dazzling authority and power. But this King came not to be served, but to be serve; not to get but to give. And in the most costly way possible: giving his life as a ransom for many. The Bible's diagnosis is that all people are in slavery to sin and death. But Jesus says his death will be the means by which we may be set free; forgiven, reconciled to God, and given eternal life. The greatest became the lowest, for our salvation.

And if we have been saved and served by Jesus, this transforms the way we live. Jesus' service of us is the fuel igniting our service to others. It is so easy to live no differently from the culture around us, self-serving, wanting power, ease and recognition. Jesus says, *Not so with you*. Instead, in our families, our workplaces, our neighbourhoods, and our church, will we follow Jesus' example of lowly, costly service? Not self-seeking, but self-sacrificing? Not 'what can I get?', but 'what can I give?' As Christ did for us.

Greetings All,

You are invited to this new 8 week series which will be held at St Mark's on Sunday's 5pm from 29<sup>th</sup> October to 16<sup>th</sup> December.

It deals with the current worship crisis in the Church, the central symptom of which is the lack of deep discipleship in our city/state/nation.

The Church has failed to enter our exalted heavenly position in Christ around the worship of the Lamb (Eph 2:6; Col 3:1-3; Heb 12:18-24). We have become ensnared in our own stories rather than sharing in God's story of creation, Incarnation, crucifixion, resurrection, recreation, new heavens and earth. A story exclusively revealed in the lived-out humanity of the Son of God. Rather than seeking the presence of God in Table (Lord's Supper, Ancient Church) or Word (Reformation) many have uniquely tried to find the presence of God through singing. We need a revival in Spirit (charisma) and communion (eucharist), "eucharismatic worship".
