Election Reminders

Register to Vote!



The Voter Registration Deadline for the November General Election is October 17th, 2023. If you are not registered or need to update your voter registration information, be sure to do so before the deadline. Register to vote online here or download a voter registration form here. Voters must re-register to vote by the deadline if you change your name, address, signature, or complete a sentence of incarceration.

Three Ways to Vote in the 2023 General

New Jersey voters have 3 ways to vote in the upcoming election:

- 1. Vote on Election Day November 7 at your polling place.
- 2. Vote early at one of your <u>county's early voting sites</u> from October 28 November 5.
- 3. Vote using a Vote-By-Mail Ballot and return the ballot in the mail, drop it in a <u>Secure Drop Box</u> in your county, or deliver it in-person to your <u>County Board of</u> <u>Elections office</u>.

How to Apply for a Vote-By-Mail Ballot

There is still time to apply for a Vote-By-Mail Ballot. To apply through the mail, the Vote-By-Mail application must be *received by* the County Clerk by **October 31, 2023.** Find Vote-By-Mail applications by county here.

Voters can also apply for a Vote-By-Mail Ballot **in-person at their County Clerk's office**. The deadline to apply in-person is 3pm on November 6th. Some County Clerk's offices will be open for *extended hours the weekend leading up to the in-person deadline* - but you need to call your County Clerk's office to check hours. <u>Find your County Clerk's address and phone number here</u>.

Apply to Vote-By-Mail

How to Return Your Vote-By-Mail Ballot

Don't wait until the last minute to return your Vote-By-Mail Ballot! You can return your completed Vote-By-Mail Ballot one of three ways:

- 1. Using a secure ballot drop box: by 8pm on Tuesday, November 7, 2023 (Election Day)
- 2. By mail: ballots must be **postmarked** by Tuesday, November 7, 2023 (Election Day)
- 3. In-person at your Board of Elections office: by 8pm on Tuesday, November 7, 2023 (Election Day)

New Legislative Districts

Remember, in 2023, voters will be casting a ballot in the **all-new legislative districts** put in place following the 2020 redistricting cycle. Make sure you know which legislative district you are voting in this election.
