## CREATIVE PORTRAIT PAINTING: EXPRESSIVE REALISM INSTRUCTOR: JUSTIN OGILVIE

Below are the 'recommended' items for this course. Similar variations of colour/ brand/ size of any item will be fine. Feel free to bring any additional materials that you already have in your artist's toolkit (e.g. different colours, brushes, etc.). Artist-grade supplies are suggested, but student-grade will suffice.

## WHAT WE PROVIDE

- Easels, side tables, chairs, containers for liquids, masking tape, and saran wrap
- For oil painters: OMS (odourless mineral spirits) \& linseed oil are provided


## SURFACES (x 7)

- 3 Surfaces: Any size between 11 " x 14 " and 12 " x 16 "
- 4 Surfaces: Any size between $12 " \times 16$ " and $16 " \times 20 "$
- Justin prefers 'canvas panel' (for easy transport)
- Canvas or gessoed hardboard panel ('Artboard' or 'Ampersand') are also welcome.
- Bring sizes you're comfortable with, depending if you prefer to work small or large.


## PAINT

Oils are recommended, but acrylics or water-based oils are welcome.

- Titanium White / Ivory Black / Viridian Green / Yellow Ochre / Burnt Sienna /Burnt Umber (or Raw Umber) / Cadmium Red Medium (or Light) / Cadmium Orange / Cadmium Yellow Medium (or Light) / Ultramarine Blue / Cerulean Blue / Alizarin Crimson Red / Dioxazine Purple
- Optional: Quinacridone Violet / Transparent Maroon (Winsor \& Newton) / Indian Yellow / Venetian Red / Gamblin's Radiant Blue, Green, \& Violet


## ACRYLICS (for all students)

## BRUSHES

Please bring whatever brushes you enjoy in a range of shapes \& sizes. Justin likes to use the following long-handled 'Rosemary \& Co' brushes:

- Bristle Filbert \& Flat: sizes 4, 6 and 7 (one of each)
- Bristle Flat: any size between 8-12 (get one)
- Synthetic Flat: sizes 6 and 10 (one of each)
- Synthetic Angle: $1 / 4$ " (get one)
- Synthetic Round: sizes 0 and 2 (one of each)
- Synthetic Fan Brush: sizes 2 and 4 (one of each)
- Eclipse Comber Filberts \& Flats: 1/4", 1/2", and 3/4" (one of each)


## MEDIUM

For Oils: Already provided are OMS (odourless mineral spirits) \& linseed oil

## For Acrylics:

- Bring a small spray water bottle to keep your paint wet.
- Optional: Acrylic 'Retarder'to extend drying time
- Optional: Use ‘Golden Open Acrylics' which stay wet for 24 hours.
