

# **ACRYLIC PAINTING FOR BEGINNERS**

While all materials can be found at *Opus Art Supplies*, similar products and brands from other stores are welcome. Suggested brand names are *'italicized'*. Additional materials are also welcome.

## WHAT WE PROVIDE

· Easels, side tables, chairs & stools, containers for liquids, masking tape, saran wrap

## **SURFACE**

- 2 surfaces: any size between 9" x 12" and 12" x 16" (bring one surface to 1st class)
- <u>Stretched canvas or gessoed hardboard panel</u> (aka 'Artboard' or 'Ampersand') canvas board is also welcome.
- Surfaces require a total of 3 layers of 'acrylic white gesso'. With pre-gessoed surfaces, please add 2 more layers, allowing to dry between layers.

### **PAINT**

It is recommended to use 'artist grade' vs. 'student grade' paint with medium or heavy body.

Titanium White / Cadmium Yellow Light (or any bright yellow) / Yellow Ochre /
Cadmium Red Light (or any bright red) / Alizarin Crimson (or Permanent Alizarin) /
Ultramarine Blue (or Cobalt Blue) / Ivory Black / Burnt Umber (or Raw Umber)

## **BRUSHES**

Please bring whatever brushes you enjoy working with in a range of shapes and sizes. We recommend the following long-handled brushes:

- 2 Synthetic Flats or Filberts (any sizes between 4, 6 and 8)
- 2–3 Synthetic Rounds (any sizes between 6–8)

<u>NOTE</u>: 'Synthetic' hairs *(aka Nylon)* are best for smooth surfaces like wooden panel. 'Natural' hairs *(hog bristle)* are best for rough surfaces, like canvas or canvas board.

## **ADDITIONAL ITEMS**

- Graphite pencil (HB)
- Pencil sharpener
- Kneaded eraser
- Small spray bottle for water (to keep your paint wet): Click HERE
- Palette Knife: 'Liquitex' Small Painting Knife #5
- Paper Towel: 'Scott's Shop Towels' (blue): Click HERE
- <u>Disposable Palette</u>: 'Richeson Grey Matters Paper Palettes' (16" x 12"): Click <u>HERE</u>
- Recommended: 'Masterson Sta-Wet Premiere Palette' (16" x 12"): Click HERE
- Recommended: Acrylic 'Retarder' to extend drying time
- Painting can be messy, please bring suitable clothing

#### **OPTIONAL**

- Gloves While Painting: Latex or 'Gorilla Grip' gloves (breathable + waterproof)
- Gloves for Brush Cleaning: Waterproof rubber gloves are recommended.
- Sketchbook 8.5" x 11" or smaller for taking notes
