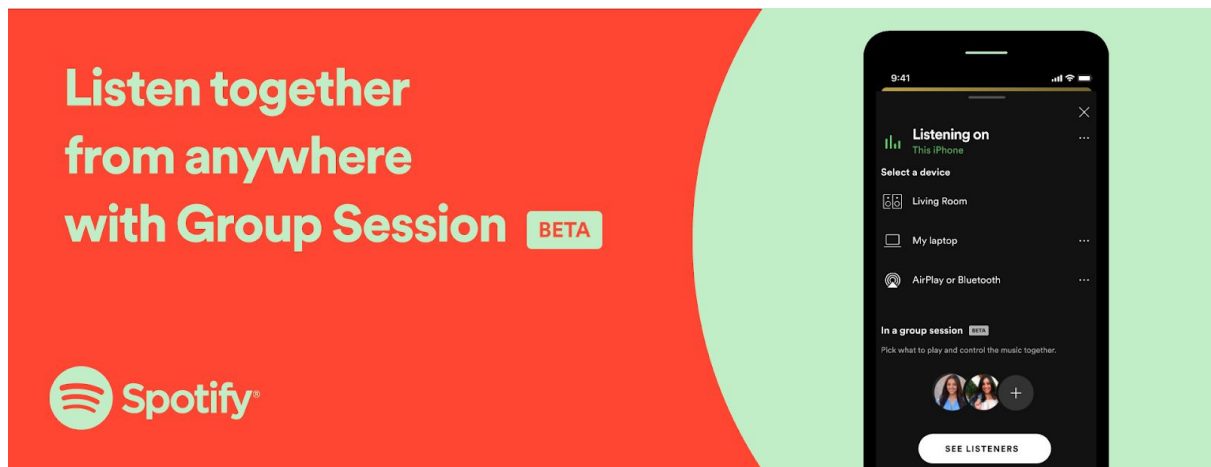


# Usability evaluation of Spotify's group session feature

# Observational evaluation

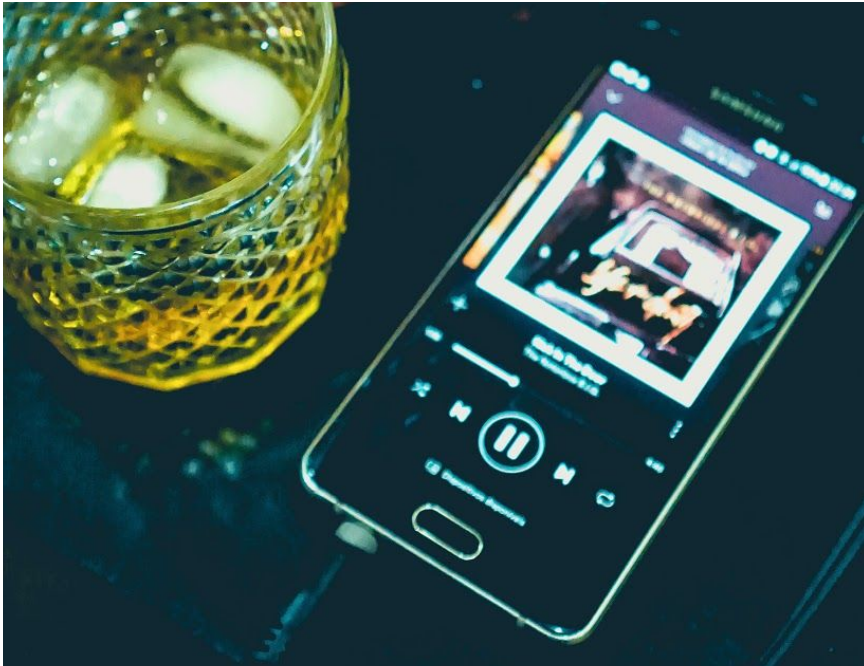
## Task 1 - Discovering group sessions

Scenario	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• You are a Spotify user and you have just been told about the group sessions feature</li><li>• Now you want to try it out</li><li>• The first step is to find out how to access it</li></ul>
Instructions	<p>Please carry out the following tasks while thinking aloud. There is no time limit but try to use the easiest possible route:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. While in the app find where the group session feature exists</li></ol>

## Task 2 - Hosting a party and inviting attendees to play a song

Scenario	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• You are hosting a party and using Spotify to play music</li><li>• Guests want to request songs</li><li>• You don't want to disrupt the flow of music by disconnecting or let them use your device</li><li>• You instead try to use the group session feature ...</li></ul>
Instructions	<p>Please carry out the following tasks while thinking aloud. There is no time limit but try to use the easiest possible route:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Start a group session</li><li>2. Invite the facilitator to the session</li><li>3. Task complete once I have joined the session</li></ol>

### Task 3 - You're a guest at a party and want to play a song

Scenario	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• You arrive at a party and you want to play one of your songs</li><li>• You speak to the host ask if you can put a song on</li><li>• They don't want to disconnect the current device and disrupt the flow or allow you to use their device</li><li>• Instead, they invite you to join the session on Spotify where you can queue a song</li></ul>
Instructions	<p>Please carry out the following tasks while thinking aloud. There is no time limit but try to use the easiest possible route:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The host invites you to join the session</li><li>2. You accept</li><li>3. Task complete once you have joined the session</li></ol>

## Post-test questionnaire
