





Swiss legislative changes: enter into force on 01 January 2022 (expected date);

EU: mandatory human rights due diligence expected (including environment and governance)

Further regulations expected: Germany, Mexico, UK, USA, Finland, Canada, Japan? NAPs: Argentina, Portugal, India, Indonesia, Pakistan, Peru, Malaysia, Morocco, Ukraine, Uganda.

More than 2,500 Zambian villagers are to receive an undisclosed settlement from UK-based mining giant Vedanta Resources over their pollution claims.






- 1. Tenancy labour and workers rights




