GEMT PROGRAM SERVICES



Ground Emergency Medical Transport (GEMT), approved in Illinois in 2019, is a federally funded program that allows Illinois fire agencies that perform emergency medical transports for Medicaid patients to submit for additional reimbursements for unrecovered costs associated with those transports. There are no annual fees for participation in the program.



PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Fire Districts seeking GEMT reimbursements must comply with the following:

- Be owned or operated by an eligible governmental entity including State, City, County and Fire Protection Districts
- Approve and file an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS)
- Be enrolled as a Medicaid provider during the period being claimed
- Provide Medical Transportation services to Medicaid recipients during the period claimed
- File an annual cost report due no later than October 1 for the recent fiscal year
