Earn Your Class 5 Driver's License (Passenger Vehicle)

- Obtain your driver's license, if you do not have one
- License must be free of graduated licensing process ("N" removed)
- Air Brakes certification may be required. Consult with training schools before you begin program.



Obtain Your Class 1 Medical

- Medical form must be completed by your family doctor and can be obtained through Registry of Motor Vehicles
- Form must be obtained within four months of tractor trailer driving course end date
- Medical conditions will be reviewed by a Board for approval of a Class 1 Upgrade



Obtain Your Driver's Abstract

- Obtain your Driver's Abstract from Registry of Motor Vehicles
- Abstract reflects your driving habits. A clean abstract is ideal. Some exceptions possible depending on infractions.



Complete Your Criminal Record Search

- Obtain search through local policing agency or RCMP detachment
- A clean search report is ideal, and enables you to cross the border



Obtain a Letter of Intent

- Letter is acknowledgement not a job offer from a trucking company that you spoke with them about the industry
- Speaking with companies and requesting the letter helps you identify career opportunities
- Letter indicates employer may hire you based on information you provided
