



For Immediate Release – October 19th, 2021

The trucking industry continues to be under a lot of pressure to meet the current freight demands within the supply chain. That pressure stems from a driver shortage, new hours of service requirements, parts shortages and limited access to new equipment. The driver shortage problem is growing, with fleets reporting up to 10% of their fleet being parked. According to Trucking HR Canada and the Canadian Trucking Alliance, there were nearly 20,000 vacant truck driver positions this year and could be as high as 30-40000 by 2023. To close these gaps, we require more training funds to make it financially viable for young people to enter the industry, more education on the opportunities within our sector and more recruitment of foreign workers.

A Connected Atlantic Canada is the mission of our Association, and our diverse board of industry professionals is excited to work with all stakeholders to move the needle forward and keep the wheels turning. On behalf of our Board, our Staff, and our 340-carrier membership, we are grateful for the support during the pandemic and appreciate our communities ongoing support as we work diligently to deliver.
