SUBCONTRACTORS INTERESTED IN BIDDING PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS

As of June 20, 2014 the State of California passed a law that requires all contractors bidding or working on **ANY** public works project to register with the State Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) and pay an annual registration fee. **Starting March 1, 2015, any contractor bidding on a public works project must be registered with the DIR in order for their bid to be deemed responsive. As of April 1, 2015, all contractors awarded a public works contract must be registered with the DIR.**

Subcontractors providing bids or work without DIR registration will result in a DIR penalty.
