These need to be more specific than "I like the book" OR "The movie was good." Include details about characters, setting, plot, problems, solutions, and other important details. This can be a bulleted list or complete sentences.

(This list will need to be turned in when the project is presented.)

After you have created your Pros and Cons list, you will decide if you liked reading the book or watching the movie better. You will, then, create a poster or front page newspaper article to persuade others to read the book OR watch the movie.

(Whichever one you preferred!)

Be sure to include:

- A title that relates to the book/movie you chose - At LEAST 4 reasons why someone should watch the movie OR read the book, in complete sentences
- Pictures/Drawings that relate to the book/movie you chose - Your name and the due date

Be creative and have fun with this project! I want to see what YOU are able to come up with!
