






## For Case Workers - First Visit

On their tablet or mobile device (iPhone or Android), Home Visitors see a list or map view of the students who have been assigned to them, along with information about each student from the school download. If required, the students can be assigned dates and priority which the Home Visitor can see on their calendar in Veoci. The Home Visitor selects a student, begins their visit, and clicks a button that says "Home Visit" to open a digital form.

During each visit, Home Visitors complete the form with both required and optional fields. (Any number of fields can be created in minutes). The GIS feature maps the location of their visit.

In addition to the form fields, the Home Visitors can enter notes and photos if needed. They can also get the parent to sign necessary forms during the visit on their mobile device. Data entered via form or notes is immediately available to all who have been given access, and also updates the management dashboards in real time.

A bonus: with text messaging built in, Home Visitors can communicate with the Managers and keep track of their interaction in the SAME student record.




## For Case Workers - Subsequent Visit

Home Visitors can see where they left off, including if they did not meet with the student during their last visit.

Home Visitors repeat the process, update the form or add more information. During and following every visit, they can add to their notes.

## For LEAP Managers - Operational Control



- Managers can see what is going on in real time: where their Home Visitors have been and the information they have gathered.
- They can message Home Visitors with additional instructions.
- They can change the next assignment for a Home Visitor or remove it with any new information they get.
- A dashboard view provides a picture of the entire operation and all visits.

## For the School District

- Insight into the absenteeism situation for the school district.
- Aggregated data and information, as opposed to conjecture and anecdotal evidence for making decisions.
- A clear and easy way to measure the progress of this program with specific data on the students visited.
- A plan for funds to engage partners who can provide the resources to address the priority needs aggregated from individual Home Visitor reports.

### So far 8 Home Visitors have:



logged 1,235 home visits (including attempted and successful)



written out 133 case notes



filled out information on 517 students in forms.

## Implementation

After our experience in New Haven, we are proposing a one-day startup for the Veoci LEAP solution. The gating function is the time it takes for the school district to sign a memorandum of understanding and provide student information



## Training

An online video or one hour session using explain - show - do repeat do is sufficient for the Home Visitors. The managers will be provided with an online half-day training for them to get the Home Visitors going. We anticipate bi-weekly two hour sessions with the managers throughout the project to help them navigate through the data, understand the metrics, and make changes in their interactions with the Home Visitors.

## State Level Aggregation Opportunity

With Veoci, data from the school district can be automatically transmitted to the State, if the district chooses to share this information and it is allowed by data sharing agreements. It is also automatically aggregated for a state-wide view with the participating school district using Veoci. Drill down to district level data is also automatic. For FERPA/HIPAA Veoci can be set up to allow those with a need to know to access the PII of individual students. This can be done at both the district level and the individual student level.
