Selection and Gift Policy

At present, the library collection consists only of printed material that has been selected to support the mission of the church. In the future, other forms of media may be added. In order to ensure that the materials are of the best quality and benefit, the following guidelines have been established:

- 1. All titles and materials are subject to approval of the Librarian and the Pastor.
- 2. The content of the material should be accurate in facts, sound in scripture interpretation and doctrine.
- 3. Titles related to religious groups and their beliefs should be respectful and objective in content.
- 4. All media should be morally sound and free from racial and religious prejudices, social injustice and other evidences of unchristian attitudes and actions.
- 5. Materials should be of high literacy and technical quality and reflect sound learning methods.
- 6. Gifts to the church library are encouraged and are subject to approval by the Librarian and the Pastor.
 - a. Gifts should meet the needs of the library.
 - b. If a person would like to purchase a book for the library, please consult with the Librarian or Pastor regarding the choice of the gift.
 - c. If a person donates money, the giver, in conjunction with the Pastor or Librarian will determine specifics regarding how the gift will be used.
