

TEU GUIDELINES | CONTACT TRACING

1

Information is only to be used if there is a COVID-19 scare (it's for public health purposes and nothing else) Your information can't be accessed and used by managers/employers. It is protected by the Privacy Act 1993.

2

Use means handing the information to health officials – no other uses are permitted.

3

All measures will stop, and all data that must be erased when the Epidemic Notice is lifted. (The Epidemic Notice is currently due to expire on 23 June but may be extended)

4

Both paper and apps are acceptable forms of data collection. Apps are not required to comply with the government's requirements for contact tracing.

5

Individuals cannot be required to put apps on their private phones.
