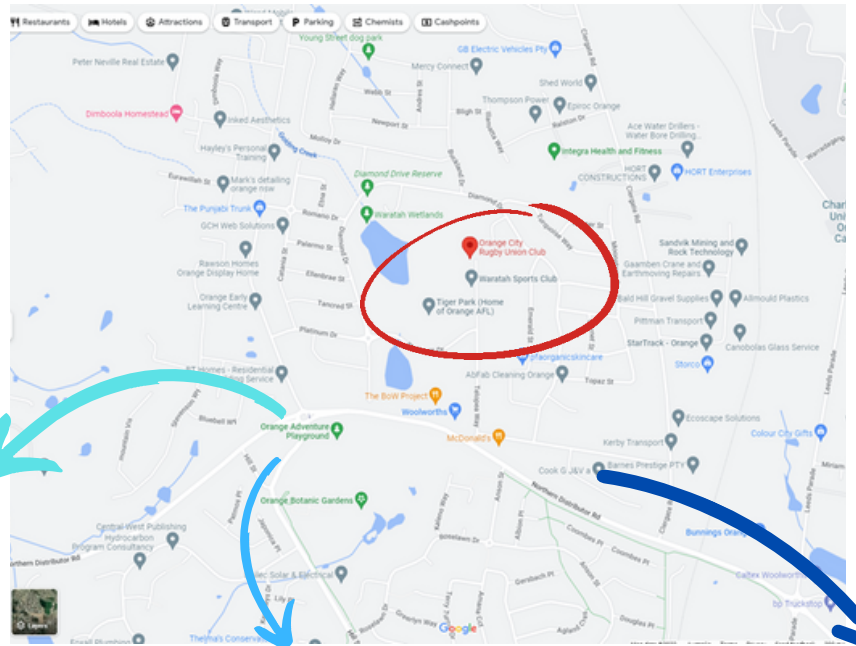

All parking donations contribute to providing qualified first aid staff for all matches

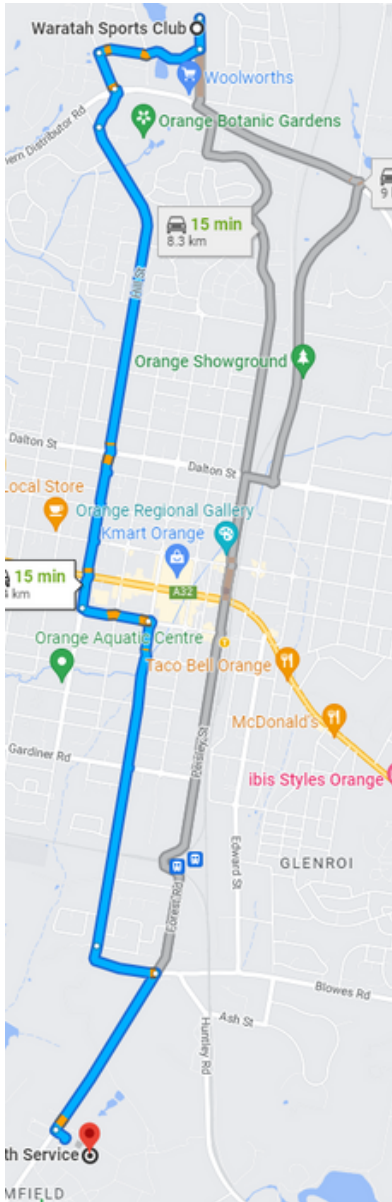


Guidelines for Attendees

Guidelines for Attendees

COVID-19

Whilst there are no current government restrictions, we ask that all attendees follow these recommendations

- PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND THE GROUNDS IF YOU HAVE ANY COLD AND FLU LIKE SYMPTOMS, REGARDLESS IF TESTED NEGATIVE ON RAPID ANTIGEN TEST.

CANTEEN FACILITIES

- Full canteen facilities will be located at Field 1 and at the top of the hill near Field 2 (marked in pink on the ground map)
- A coffee van will also be parked on the grounds for coffee sales only
- We ask that you remember that no cooking implements are allowed due to insurance requirements.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Glassware or crockery of any kind, bottles, cups, glasses, plates
 - This is primarily for player safety
- BBQ or cooking facilities or implements of any kind
 - Due to insurance requirements and safety concerns
- Alcohol of any sort
 - In line with the CWJRU constitution for junior matches.
- Illegal drugs

If any of these items are found at any time over the weekend they will be confiscated and may be collected by the owners after the competition ends on Monday 12th June 2023.
