





NSWJRU UNDER 15s STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS 2023

ST LUKES PARK, CONCORD

June 10 - 12

Welcome

A big welcome from the West Harbour Rugby community to St Lukes Park Concord for the Under 15s State Championships! Games will take place on St Lukes 2 and 3 fields, which are adjacent to each other, as well as St Lukes North, a 5 minute walk away. We hope your time with us is an enjoyable one.

Nearest shopping precincts

- Concord West, Majors Bay Road (Supermarket plus pharmacies),
- **Five Dock**, Great North Road (Supermarket plus pharmacies);
- Burwood, Burwood Road (lots of shops but parking is almost impossible!)

First Aid

Qualified First Aid Officers will be available at both grounds. The First Aider will have ice on hand to be applied where appropriate for the treatment of injuries after the player has been assessed. Any player requiring ice must be seen by the First Aid Officer — ice will not be handed out.

Concussion: In the event of a player receiving a head or neck injury, or if any player is suspected of being concussed, the player must be referred to the First Aid officer.

Ambulances: Under no circumstances should any person on site call an ambulance. The First Aid Officer will triage events, and call an ambulance if required.

Medical Emergency: The nearest hospital is Concord Hospital, Hospital Road, Concord.

Ground Marshalls

Each Club should provide a Ground Marshall to manage their own teams. An additional Ground Marshall will be assigned to each field, and will be responsible for

- ensuring all players and officials remain in the designated zones;
- ensuring that the behaviour of players, officials and spectators conforms to the Rugby Australia Code of Conduct, and that inappropriate behaviour is reported to NSWRU.

Coffee, Canteen and BBQ

A canteen, BBQ and coffee vans will operate at both locations. No club or individual BBQs are permitted.

Rubbish

Garbage bins will be provided around each ground. However, **please bring strong rubbish bags** with you, and ensure that your team area is cleaned each day.

Code of Conduct

All team officials, players, parents and spectators must adhere to the Rugby Australia Code of Conduct. There is zero tolerance of match official abuse: anyone who breaches this code of conduct will be ejected from the championships and grounds.

Alcohol

No alcohol is to be brought onto any ground, or consumed during the tournament.

Parking

See the map at the end. Ample parking can be found at the following locations (all in close proximity to playing fields). Parking is marked with a \mathbf{P} on the maps below.

- P1 a sizeable car park on Crane Street, adjacent to St Lukes North field.
- P2 along Crane Street, adjacent to St Lukes North.
- P3 at Concord Community Centre off Gipps Street.
- P4 along Stanley Street, opposite Concord High School but DO NOT PARK INSIDE THE SCHOOL, AS YOU MAY BE LOCKED IN!!
- P5 underneath the new Concord Oval Sports centre.
- P6 next to Cintra Park tennis courts.

Transport

- Train —nearest station Burwood (10 minutes walk)
- **Bus** 461 to city or Burwood on Parramatta Road (5 minutes walk from St Lukes 2,3)

Warm Up Facilities

These are indicated on the attached map

- St Lukes #1 the soccer field but not Sunday morning before 11.00am, as it is booked for dog training!
- St Lukes North adjacent to the playing field.

Concord Oval is not available for warm up.

Amenity blocks

Toilets are indicated on the map. There are no change room facilities.


Marquees

Marquees can be placed adjacent to St Lukes 2 and 3 off Crane Street, on the Gipps side of St Lukes 3, or on the side of St Luke 1. Also on the Crane street side of St Lukes North. Please keep the marquees well back from the playing area, including dead ball lines — at least 5 metres. If you have multiple canopies, please erect the second and subsequent canopies **behind** the front one.
