

NSWJRU Under 12 State Championships - 2023



Camden Rugby Park Wire lane, Camden South Camden Rugby Club is again proud to be hosting the NSWJRU Under 12s State Championships from Saturday 10th through to Monday 12th June. This is the 14th consecutive year that our club has held this carnival.

We welcome all our visitors to Camden and the Camden area & hope that the following information will help make your weekend easy to manage and enjoyable.

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1. Introduction

Camden Rugby Club wish to extend a warm welcome to all of the competing representative teams.

This document provides details relating to location, parking, entry, team assembly locations, warm up areas, signing-on, first aid, change room facilities, toilet amenities, canteen facilities, photography, and hours of access.

Camden Rugby Club provides food, beverage and liquor from the clubhouse.

- Due to Licensing requirements, NO ALCOHOL MAY BE BROUGHT INTO THE GROUND.
- Due to insurance requirements, **NO BBQ OR COOKING FACILITIES** may be brought into the ground.

COVID Requirements

Camden Rugby Club wishes to ensure the safety and health of all our players, parents, supporters and team's staff. Currently there are no government restrictions, relating to Covid, but ask that you obey any government Covid requirements that may apply at the time of the Championships.

If these requirements require the use of PPE (such as face masks) we request that all members of your team management and their supporters bring these items with them as they cannot be supplied by Camden Rugby Club.

If Covid restrictions are in force over the period of the Championships you are requested to follow the directions and advice of the designated Covid Marshall.

2. Location

Wire Lane, Camden South.

Turn West from Camden Valley Way, into Wire Lane. Camden Valley Inn is prominent on the corner.

Proceed to the end of Wire Lane; drive over the hump; continue straight ahead to Camden Rugby Park.

General Parking is in the marked area **<u>BEFORE</u>** entry to the grounds.

See attached location and site map. Location is in the SW corner of the map.

Please note - Google maps directions indicates that Wire Lane is accessible from Cawdor Road. This is incorrect so do not rely on Google Maps.

3. Parking

- Each team will be allocated two (2 only) car parking spaces within the ground. Allocated vehicles will be permitted to initially park adjacent to their team area, to unpack.
 - Vehicles from team areas at the Southern end of Field 1 will then be directed to the Parking Area at the southern end of the main field
 - Vehicles from team areas at the North-West end of the clubhouse will be directed to the Parking Area at the northern end of Field 2
 - Please check the attached Site Map
- Team managers will be issued with 2 parking permits daily, which must be displayed to allow entry to the ground. There are NO exceptions.
 - Permits for Saturday will be sent to Team Managers as soon as teams are finalised
 - Permits for Sunday and Monday will be issued to Team Managers on Saturday morning, at team registration in the clubhouse
- ALL other vehicles may park in the general parking area. Entry to this area is before the main gate. Ground marshals will provide directions.
- Mobility Parking there are disabled parking spaces available behind the clubhouse. Normal disabled parking restrictions apply, ie. Current MPS pass displayed.

4. Entry

Entry to the ground is via the main gate; easily accessible from the car park; or from the Northern end of the car park, between Grounds 1 & 2 (through the trees).

NOTE: Entry fee is daily by way of a gold coin donation. This money goes to support Camden Rugby Juniors.

5. Competition

The competition draw is provided by NSW Junior Rugby. Please note the following:

- Presently, there are 18 teams in the Competition
- Game times will be as per JSC requirements
- Size 4 footballs will be used
- The top 2 teams in EACH Pool progress to the Qtr Finals

Remaining teams play off for 9th to 18th positions for seeding purposes.

6. Team Locations

- Each team will be allocated a specified grassed area, for the purpose of erecting a marquee or shelter. These allocated areas vary between 120 and 180m2, depending on location. There will be plenty of spare space around these designated areas for families to set up around their respective teams.
- Teams wishing to erect a marquee/shelter do so at their own risk. Ground will be open on Friday evening if Managers wish to erect tents or marquees.
- The Camden Rugby Club, nor its members will not accept any responsibility for any damage to a marquee/shelter, or caused by the marquee/shelter.
- Teams wishing to leave their marquee/shelter erected overnight do so at their own risk. Neither the Camden Rugby Club, nor its members will accept any responsibility for loss or damage to the marquee/shelter.

7. Sign On

Per the NSWJSC competition rules, Sign-On's must be completed **45 minutes prior to the team's first match of the day**. Signing on is **NOT required on subsequent days**; however, Managers must notify the Registrar of any player changes for the Sunday and/or Monday; and, any player who has not previously signed on, must sign Registration Sheet prior to their first match.

The Sign On location is up the ramp at the rear of the clubhouse, & <u>NOT</u> through the Clubhouse.

8. Game Requirements

- You are required to provide a qualified AR for the game **prior** to your team's game (per JSC requirements)
- Each team is also to supply a ball & ball boy/girl for their own matches.
- Each team is to provide a Ground Marshall (per JSC requirements) who is responsible for managing team and their spectators' behavior. They are to report to the (Camden Rugby Club) Ground Coordinator desk, at the centre of each ground. *The Marshall is NOT to walk up and down the sideline, but is to remain within the vicinity of their team area.*
- All players, parents, guardians, coaches & officials from all teams are to ensure their behaviour is with expectations set down by the Rugby Australia code of conduct. Failure to do so will result in removal from our grounds.

9. Warm Up Areas

The warm up area is at the northern end of our grounds, (at the far end of field 2 & please refer to the site map). There will be some vehicles moving around during the day as well as large amounts of supporters. So to allow plenty of space for people to move around, we ask that you limit your team warm up to this area only.

10. First Aid/Medical

Identifiable First Aid will be available throughout the carnival, in the area between Ground 1 and Ground 2. There will not be a doctor on site. Hospital location details:

- a. Campbelltown Hospital Therry Rd, Campbelltown; ph 4634 3000
- b. Camden Hospital Menangle Rd, Camden in 99% of cases, you can be expected to be re-directed to Campbelltown Hospital
- c. An extended hours medical centre can be located in Gregory Hills

11. Change Rooms

There are 2 change rooms available in the upper floor of the clubhouse. Team Managers are to be responsible for the conduct of players whenever they are using these facilities. PLEASE DO NOT wear boots beyond the passageway to the change rooms, or within the clubhouse. Each change room has shower and toilet facilities.

12. Toilet Amenities

Portable toilets will be at 2 locations: at the Southern end of the Clubhouse; and between Grounds 1 & 2. Toilets are also available inside the clubhouse, next to the change rooms. A separate disabled toilet is available inside the clubhouse.

13. Team Dinners

Through the generosity of our Club Sponsor, the Camden Valley Inn, they have made available the option of a team dinners on the Sunday night in their function room. The cost will be \$10 for options from the kids menu, plus free soft drink for the kids tables. (please see their website: <u>Camden Valley Inn</u>. for menu options or call them on 02 4655 8413 to make a booking

14. Canteen Facilities

There will be 2 canteens in operation; at the front of the clubhouse on field 1 & under the awning of the facilities shed between fields 1 & 2. A range of hot and cold food and hot and cold drinks will be available at these locations, & will be available from 8am on each day of the carnival.

If arranged prior to the carnival, we can also provide meal vouchers for any or all days of the carnival for all members of your squad.

Coffee vendors will be located adjacent to both grounds.

An ATM is available at the canteen.

The licenced bar will be open from midday (or later at club's discretion) each day. Liquor licence requirements apply.

NOTE: Any alcohol products MUST be consumed within the licenced area of the clubhouse, including the verandah. NO alcohol drinks are to be taken from this area

15. Photography

A professional photographer assigned by NSWJRU, may be in attendance at the ground, on selected days. Photos of players from all games will be available from the distribution point adjacent to Ground 1.

16. Hours of Access

Ground entry will be available from 7am each day, and from Friday

afternoon. Club grounds will close at 7pm each day.

Requests for permission to camp overnight will be considered. Refer contact below




