GROUND LAYOUT GUIDE

ERIC TWEEDALE STADIUM

Eric Tweedale Stadium, affectionately known to locals as "The Eric" is home to the Western Sydney Two Blues Rugby Club, and our Two Blues Junior District Rugby Club. We welcome you to our home ground, and hope you enjoy your experience here. Be sure to ask around of Eric Tweedale if you have not heard or met him before, and you never know when he may pop in to catch a piece of the Rugby action!

TEAM MARQUEES

Team Marquees are to set up around the Main Field of Eric Tweedale Stadium only. Once signing in you will be given your spot via our Ground Marshall.

Teams are responsible for their own Marquees, including pegging and securing to the ground. **Note**-Tents setup along the hill parallel to the touch line on Eric Tweeddale Stadium main field, must be weary of underground irrigation. Please use weights on your gazebo in this area.

Team Marquees can be left overnight if lowered and safe from blowing over in windy conditions, as the Stadium is locked up after hours however there will be no provision of security services overnight. Teams are responsible for their own equipment and personal items at all times.

MANAGER'S BRIEFING – SATURDAY 10 JUNE

A Team Manager's meeting will take place at 8am on Saturday 10 June in the Function Room of the Eric Tweedale Stadium. This room is located on the top floor of the Stadium and is accessible by stairs or lift.

REGISTRATION DESK

The Player's / Team's Registration Desk will be located inside the Main Entrance to the Stadium.

TEAM WARM UP AREAS

All Teams will have access to external spaces for warm up (see map below)

Teams playing in 9am matches can use the allocated Field of Play for Warm Up.

Please note Granville Park has NOT been updated on Google Maps, so the aerial view will differ to reality.

Teams are requested to be back in the change rooms at least 5 minutes before the scheduled kick-off time and ready to go. There are only 7 accessible change rooms.

GROUND LAYOUT



Changerooms are located in the Eric Tweedale Stadium and Granville Park.

Teams will be expected to remove all belongings from Changerooms prior to the commencement of their respective matches to ensure the next team has access.

Each changeroom can seat approx. 23 players on the bench seats and there are toilets and showers in each of the change-rooms.

Access to Fields B/C and D is an easy walk from the Stadium.

Each Team is responsible for:

- Ice
- Strapping tape
- Medical staff & Physio's
- Medical bed / table
- Cleaning the changerooms (rubbish placed in bins provided) and all items removed when leaving

Any damage to a change-room will be the responsibility of the Club using the change-room.

All Teams are responsible for the safe keeping of their belongings. While Two Blues will provide a level of security around the Ground and the Changerooms, Teams must take full responsibility for any lost or stolen items.

CHANGEROOM ALLOCATIONS

Changerooms have been allocated on a "Field of Play" basis.

- Teams that are due to play on Field A will use Changerooms 1 +2 in the Stadium)
- Teams that are due to play on **Field B** will need to share use of Changeroom 3 in the Stadium as Changeroom 4 is not available.
- Teams that are due to play on Field C/D will use share changerooms located on Field C.

Teams will be expected to remove all belongings from Changerooms prior to the commencement of their respective matches to ensure the next team has access.

FIELD ALLOCATIONS

Please consult the Match Day Draw for any updates to Field Allocations.

Access to Fields B/ C/ D is an easy walk from the Stadium.

MEDICAL ROOM

There is an onsite Medical Room at Eric Tweedale Stadium.

This will only be used to triage emergency cases for injured players or medical service to a spectator.

The Medical Room is not to be used for pre-game strapping.

Coaches, Players, and Parents are not to enter the Medical Room unless required to so under supervision.

REFEREES ROOM

There is on an onsite Referees Room with 2 x Toilets and Showers.

Two Blues will also provide a breakout area on the Main Concrete Balcony of Eric Tweedale Stadium for our referees to have their own fenced off area.

These areas are not to be accessed by players, spectators, or team management.
