Throughout the Nursery Rooms, the organisation of the day varies according to the age and needs of the children. An example of a typical day might look like....



7:30am

Early Starters

8:00am Breakfast

8:30am

The majority of children arrive and are welcomed into their rooms. The children are able to spend time exploring the resources that have been set up

#### 9:05am

Children have some time together to sing a hello song and learn more about the day

#### 9:30am

Free Flow Play, indoors and outdoors with adults scaffolding the children's learning and supporting their development

#### 10:00am

Snack time - children are invited to share in a snack and as they gain in independence help with pouring, peeling and cutting

#### 10:30am

The children continue to learn through play and exploration

#### 11:35am

Story and Singing time

#### 12:00 noon

Lunchtime with the adults eating with the children, encouraging them to try new foods, develop independence and modelling good table manners

#### 1:00pm

Nap time - Staff discuss individual children's sleeping needs with parents and plan accordingly Or Free Flow Play

#### 2:15pm

Snack time

#### 2:00pm-4:00pm

The children continue to learn through play and exploration

#### 4:00pm

Stories, Songs and Rhymes

#### 4,30pm

Going Home Time or Tea Time

#### 6:00pm

Late Stay Collection and Going Home Time


Throughout the week, the children will have the opportunity to visit the Forest School Area and Mud Kitchen and participate in physical activities such as Yoga.
