HIGHLIGHTS

The Executive Committee of the Canadian Home Economics Foundation, based in Winnipeg, held seven (7) meetings during the 2011 - 2012 fiscal year, ending April 30. Nine provincial / regional trustees chair awards committees and distribute information about the Foundation to local meetings and conferences. Dr. Elizabeth Feniak, CM, PhD is the Honorary Chair and Trustee Emeritus. The Canadian Home Economics Foundation operates with volunteers and no paid staff.

The 31st Annual Meeting and Donor Recognition was held on October 15, 2011 at the University of Winnipeg, MB in conjunction with the Manitoba Association of Home Economists Annual Conference. The Board of Trustees meeting was held October 14, 2011 in Winnipeg, MB.

From May 1, 2011 to April 30, 2012 funding of \$33,747 was approved for twenty-two grants and awards across Canada and internationally in the areas of research, education, public service and post-secondary education and training. Donations and bequests totaled \$36,570.

Isabel Palmeter and Eleanor Menzies have served the Foundation for 31 years and 15 years respectively and have both agreed to extend their term of office for an additional three years. Kathy Weisbrod is leaving the Board of Directors and we thank her for her contributions for the past six years.




