Re: Update on Air Cargo Advance Screening

Dear Valued Client,

In June 2018, CBP published an interim final rule regarding the Air Cargo Advance Screening program (ACAS) going live on June 12, 2018. The purpose of this advisory is a reminder that the informed compliance period for ACAS ends on June 11, 2019. The one-year informed compliance period was meant to provide the trade enough time to make any necessary business process changes in order to comply with the new requirements. Effective June 12, 2019, carriers are not permitted to ship cargo to the US without satisfactory completion of the ACAS risk assessment.

JAS Forwarding (USA) has been involved in the ACAS pilot for several years. JAS has been effectively filing ACAS for quite some time now and prepared for the June 12th enforcement date. The impact of this order should be minimal. JAS USA 24-hour ACAS Compliance Team will be monitoring any and all potential issues received by CBP.
