Re: USTR Releases Product Exclusion Process for Chinese Products Subject to Section 301 Tariffs

Dear Valued Client,

On June 20th, The Office of the U.S. Trade Representative (USTR) announced that they would establish a process by which U.S. stakeholders may request that particular products classified within a covered tariff subheading to be excluded from the additional duties.

This week, a notice was issued that sets out the specific procedures and criteria related to requests for product exclusions.

USTR must receive requests to exclude a particular product by October 9, 2018.
