### CITY OF KIMBALL TRASH DUMPSTERS

The City of Kimball reminds customers:

- ◆ Brown dumpsters are to be used for household waste only.
- ◆ Green dumpsters are for grass, leaves, tree branches thumb size, 3 feet and smaller.

The City of Kimball Street Department also reminds customers that the alleyways have a 20 foot leeway. Please do not place anything in the alleyway, such as gardens or small buildings. Weeds and grass must be kept mowed and trimmed as well.
