

Prattsburgh Wind Farm Steuben County, NY

3-DAY NOTICE OF INTENT TO FILE AN APPLICATION

Prattsburgh Wind, LLC, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Terra-Gen, LLC, is proposing to construct a major electric generating facility under Section 94-c of the Executive Law. This notice announces that on or about **September 23, 2022** Prattsburgh Wind will file an Application pursuant to Section 94-c of the New York State Executive Law (94-c Process), seeking a permit from the Office of Renewable Energy Siting authorizing the construction and operation of the Facility. A 60-day notice of Intent to File an Application was previously published in accordance with 19 NYCRR §900-1.3(d) on or about May 13, 2022. The 94-c Process has been implemented by rules enacted by the Office of Renewable Energy Siting and establishes a review process with uniform standards and conditions for all renewable energy projects. The uniform standards and conditions are available at 19 NYCRR 900.6 and <https://ores.ny.gov/regulations>.

The Prattsburgh Wind Farm, is a 147 megawatt (MW) wind-powered electric generating facility proposed to be located in the Towns of Prattsburgh, Avoca, Cohocton, Howard, and Wheeler in Steuben County, New York (the “Facility”). The purpose of the proposed Facility is to generate wind-powered electricity that will provide a significant source of renewable electricity to the New York State power grid. Under the 2019 Climate Leadership and Community Protection Act, New York State has committed to generating all electricity from renewable sources by 2040. The proposed Facility will help New York achieve that mandate. The Facility will include the installation and operation of up to 37 wind turbines, together with the associated electrical collection lines (below ground and overhead), access roads, meteorological towers, operation and maintenance (“O&M”) building, and collector substation. Prattsburgh Wind will also construct a new point of interconnect (“POI”) substation and 230-kV high-voltage loop-in and loop-out transmission lines (“NYSEG Facilities”) adjacent to its collector substation. Upon completion, the ownership of these NYSEG Facilities will be transferred over to NYSEG.

Upon filing the Application, Prattsburgh Wind will provide funding in the amount of \$147,000 to be deposited into a local agency account to be made available to local agencies and potential community intervenors for the purpose of contributing to a complete record leading to an informed permit decision as to the appropriateness of the site and the facility, and for local agencies, shall include the use of funds to determine whether a proposed facility is designed to be sited, constructed and operated in compliance with applicable local laws and regulations.

Any local agency or potential community intervenor shall submit a request for initial funding **within thirty (30) days of the date of application filing** and such requests can be made to:
