

CROCHET CIRCLE

This crochet circle was made by a member of the Hackney Elderly Caribbean Organisation (HECO). The design is formed from red, blue and white yarn.

This object was donated, and is part of the Museum of London's **Collecting 2000** project, which sought to document everyday life at the turn of the millennium by acquiring objects such as this. In 2012, this included collecting social media posts relating to the 2012 Olympic Games.

HECO Statement: 'This piece of crochet work was made by an octogenarian member of our group who suffers from severe arthritis in her hands. This craftswoman, in common with all the other elderly members, donates the income from the arts and crafts classes to assist the funds of the organisation.'
