Since 2006, Foundation Music School has provided student-centered, holistic music education emphasizing reading, improvisation, theory, technique, and composition to the northern Colorado region.

While piano (47% of total lessons) and violin (31% of total lessons) are our most popular private lessons, we offer one-onone instruction for voice and just about any instrument you can think of. Our faculty is skilled in engaging young, aspiring musicians and has had a retention rate of 63.3% in the past year.

Gift certificates and financial assistance are available for music instruction.

The need for our music therapy services has been growing. Our staff has worked tirelessly to help everyone who comes to us. Every dollar you donate directly helps a child heal from debilitating genetic, developmental, or psychological condition that may prevent participation in a school setting or seeking employment.

Unfortunately, despite its proven effectiveness, music therapy is not covered by health insurance, leaving many people without access to this valuable form of treatment. We raise money throughout the year to prevent turning families away.

PSD EARLY MUSIC PROGRAM



Our music therapy team serves 1,040 students from 3-5 years of age each week from 65 classrooms in 21 elementary schools for the 37-week school year. More than 38,000 opportunities to prepare incoming Kindergarteners to succeed in school. Generously funded by The Serimus and Bohemian Foundations.

PRIVATE MUSIC THERAPY



Music Therapy is a powerful and

evidence-based form of therapy that has been shown to provide immense benefits to those with a wide range of physical, emotional, and psychological conditions to people of all ages. We serve 75 music therapy clients and their families each week.

Our music therapists are mastersprepared with an average of 10 years of clinical experience.

PRIVATE MUSIC INSTRUCTION



We teach more than 200 weekly private lessons. 32% of our students receive financial assistance from The Serimus Foundation – up to 100%. Learning an instrument improves coordination, time management, and organization skills. Students report better concentration, improved reading/math and listening skills. We offer Private/group instruction for instrument/voice to students of all ages. Our highly educated and qualified faculty has more than 100 combined years of teaching experience.

CLASSES, CAMPS & OUTREACH



More than 1,000 youth and adults participate in weekly programs to teach and inspire. Our out-of-school camp series helps working parents on teacher conference days while providing music, movement, and art experiences for our campers. 100 children attend weekly family music classes with their caregivers for early childhood music (infants to elementary school aged students.)
