Origin

Our Fuding tea gardens sit at an elevation of 1,640 feet. Fuding is both a mountainous and coastal city, allowing ocean breezes and mountain valleys to shape the area's climate.

Tasting Notes

The liquor is a clear, pale yellow with a silken texture. Tasters note a range of flavors and aromas that include the faintly sweet, herbaceous notes found in the meadow and wildflower honey.

Used In

Bai Mu Dan can be enjoyed as a standalone tea, or in blends. Its gentle character allows it to be easily used with other ingredients, but can also be quickly overpowered. Bai mu dan can be found in RTD formulations, and craft brewers also use it in craft tea beers, hard seltzers, and kombucha.
