 Disclosures should be on each frame or video of story. Put on the first frame of story with ongoing disclosures if the endorsement continues for multiple frames / videos / posts. 	 Place disclosure at the end of a story (or the last frame or video).
 Verbally as well as visually disclose sponsorship if content is a video. 	 Fail to verbally disclose sponsorship if content is a video.

Disclosures are required when an influencer has a "material connection" with the brand. A material connection to the brand includes a personal, family or employment relationship, or a financial relationship—such as the brand paying you or giving you free or discounted products or services.
