#### **RESOLUTION 21-11**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOLBROOK, ARIZONA RESCINDING ALL PREVIOUS RESOLUTIONS CONTAINING FEE SCHEDULES WITH RESPECT TO THE HOLBROOK MAGISTRATE COURT AND ADOPTING A NEW FEE SCHEDULE.

WHEREAS, the City of Holbrook is authorized pursuant to A.R.S. 22-404(E), and by the Holbrook City Code Section 1-5-3 to establish and assess fees for court programs and services: and

WHEREAS, it is the purpose of this resolution to update the administrative fee schedule to allow the City of Holbrook to defray the actual costs of services provided by the Magistrate court where these costs are a burden to the taxpayer and should be borne by those individuals responsible for them.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOLBROOK, ARIZONA:

**SECTION 1:** All previous resolutions relating to fees schedules for the Holbrook Magistrate Court are hereby rescinded and repealed.

**SECTION 2:** The following fees for court programs and services for the Holbrook Magistrate Court are hereby adopted:

**SECTION 2.01 - COURT COLLECTION FEE**: The Magistrate Court incurs significant costs in connection with the collection of fines imposed. Accordingly, there is hereby imposed an administrative fee of twenty dollars (\$20.00) per case to be collected in all cases filed in the Magistrate court in which it is necessary for the defendant to consult with the court collections officer for the purpose of making financial arrangements to pay a fine or where it is necessary for the court collection officer to assist with the collection of fines. This fee may be waived only in cases of extreme financial hardship as determined by the City Magistrate.

**SECTION 2.02 - FTA WARRANT FEE:** The Magistrate Court incurs substantial costs in criminal (including criminal traffic) cases where the defendant fails to appear and a Failure to Appear (FTA) warrant must be issued and processed. Accordingly, there is hereby imposed an administrative fee of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) per case to be collected in criminal cases filed in the Magistrate Court in which an FTA warrant is issued. This fee shall be imposed in each criminal case in which an FTA warrant is issued unless the defendant establishes by a preponderance of the evidence that the failure to appear was legally justified. This fee may be waived only in cases of extreme financial hardship as determined by the City Magistrate, or in cases where the FTA warrant is quashed for good cause shown and the City Magistrate determines that a waiver is appropriate.

SECTION 2.03 - CIVIL TRAFFIC DEFAULT FEE: The Magistrate Court incurs substantial costs in civil traffic cases where the defendant defaults in the payment of a civil sanction and the court must take steps to collect the sanction. Accordingly, there is hereby imposed and administrative fee of thirty dollars (\$30.00) per case to be collected in civil traffic cases filed in the Magistrate Court where the defendant defaults in the payment of a civil sanction. This fee may be waived only in cases of extreme financial hardship as determined by the City Magistrate.

**SECTION 2.04 - COURT AUTOMATION FEE:** The Magistrate Court has established a coordinated plan for the automation of cases and cash flow management and seeks to offset the annual maintenance and support of automation equipment and programs. Accordingly, there is hereby imposed a court

automation fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) per case to be collected in cases filed in the Magistrate Court. This fee may be waived only in cases of extreme financial hardship as determined by the City Magistrate.

**SECTION 2.05 - COURT USER & STAFFING FEE:** There is hereby imposed a Magistrate Court user fee of thirty dollars (\$30.00) to be collected in cases filed in the Magistrate Court. This fee shall be collected as follows: (1) from the defendant as part of the fines, fees and surcharges imposed in each criminal action resulting in a conviction, said fee to be collected on each separate count of which the defendant is convicted; (2) from the defendant as part of the civil sanctions, fees and assessments in each civil traffic action in which a judgment is entered in favor of the City/State, said fee to be collected on each separate violation as to which a judgment is entered in favor of the City/State; and (3) from the defendant as part of the civil sanction in any civil action brought pursuant to the Holbrook City Code in which a judgment is entered in favor of the Plaintiff/City/State, said fee to be collected on each separate violation as to which a judgement is entered in favor of the Plaintiff/City/State. This fee may be waived only in cases of extreme financial hardship as determined by the City Magistrate.

**SECTION 2.06 - HANDLING OF FUNDS:** The fees collected pursuant to this resolution shall be deposited monthly with the City of Holbrook's finance Department and accounted for separately for the purposes set forth herein.
