Guidelines

- 1. Scholarships are available for \$100 per classroom/field trip or \$25 per teacher/teacher training opportunities.
- 2. Scholarships will take the form of a discount in field trip or workshop fees.
- 3. Individual teachers may apply for one classroom field trip scholarship and one professional development scholarship per school year. Please note that funding is limited, and so in an effort to benefit as many students and teachers as possible, consecutive year funding to previous recipients may not always be available.
- 4. Applications must be received at least one month prior to the desired field trip date.
- 5. Teachers will be notified of funding availability within two weeks of submitting an application.
- 6. Scholarships must be used within 6 months of notification of approval. Please see information below on programs and booking requirements.

This could be in the form of individual student letters, a copy of completed post visit activities or photos of student projects, etc. *Note: failure to provide this could jeopardize future scholarship funding.
