NATIONAL TEAM HIGHLIGHTS:

2019: At the World Cup in Thailand, Sarah played all 7 games helping Team Canada finish sixth overall. She averaged 19.9 minutes, 5.1 points, 2.3 rebounds, and 1.3 assists per game.

2018: In the Latvia Tournament, Sarah played 60 minutes and averaged 9 points per game, 2.33 rebounds per game and 1.67 assists per game. At the World Cup in Belarus, she played seven games and contributed 59 points, 28 assists and 10 rebounds.

2017: This was Sarah's first time representing Canada at international competition. She played in all 5 games of the tournament, and logged a total of 109 minutes, playing on average 21.8 minutes per game. Throughout the tournament she scored a total of 43 points, averaging 8.6 per game. On top if this Sarah was ranked 3rd in the tournament for the most steals with 21.

PROVINCIAL TEAM HIGHLIGHTS:

2018: Sarah was a key contributor at the U17 National Championship where Team Quebec won silver. She was named a 1st Team All-Star and averaged 28.2 minutes per game, 14.6 points per game and 4.0 rebounds per game.

2016: While participating at the U17 National Championships, Sarah posted impressive numbers including playing an average of 27.8 minutes per game and scoring an average of 12.2 points per game. She was a key member of the team and logged the most minutes on the court throughout the tournament for Team Quebec. These numbers got her being named to the 2nd All-Star Team from the tournament.

2015: While at the 2015 U15 National Championships, Sarah played in all 5 games playing a total of 128 minutes, averaging 25.7 per game. On top of this, she averaged 13.2 points per game, a team high along with leading the team in steals with 23. These numbers got her being named to the 1st All-Star Team from the tournament.
