## NATIONAL TEAM HIGHLIGHTS:

**2020:** Member of the FIBA Olympic Qualifying Tournament team that went 3-0 and secured Canada's third consecutive Olympic appearance. Nurse averaged 16 points, 6 rebound and 4 assists during the OQT in Belgium.

**2019:** Playing her 7<sup>th</sup> year with the Senior Women's National Team, Kia started all 3 games in the FIBA Olympic Prequalifying Tournament and averaged 15.7 points per game, 2.7 rebounds per game, and shot 100% from the free throw line.

**2018:** Kia joined Team Canada for final phase following the WNBA season. She contributed a total of 31 points within two games at the USA exhibition. In France, Nurse played in all three games averaging 24.3 minutes per game. During, the World Cup Nurse contributed a total of 109 points, 16 assists, and 8 steals throughout the tournament. She finished 3<sup>rd</sup> in points per game and total points for the entire World Cup where Team Canada finished in 7<sup>th</sup> place.

**2017:** In her first tournament of the 2017 season with the Senior National Team, she contributed significantly to the Gold Medal win at the FIBA Women's AmeriCup. She averaged 21.1 minutes per game, and 10.5 points per game along with 2.2 rebounds per game. During the France Exhibition, Kia averaged 24.3 minutes per game contributing 35 points, 3 assists, and 9 rebounds.

**2016:** Member of the Rio 2016 Olympic Team who placed 7<sup>th</sup> in the tournament; was the top performer in the game against Serbia scoring 25 points; averaged 11 points per game, 2.3 assists and 25.6 minutes Played 3 games with the Senior National team in the USA Showcase exhibition tournament, averaging 26.4 minutes and 5.3 points per game.

**2015:** Member of the 2015 Pan American Games team that won Canada's first ever gold medal. Averaged 25.5 minutes and 12.8 points per game. Finished 3<sup>rd</sup> in scoring, 7<sup>th</sup> for made free throws, 8<sup>th</sup> in three pointers, and top 10 in assists for the tournament. Played in three exhibition games in Spain averaging 20.33 minutes and 8.0 points per game. Played in three exhibition games in France averaging 27.52 minutes and 11.0 points per game. Helped the SWNT achieve gold at the FIBA Americas, qualifying for Rio 2016 Olympics... Named MVP of the tournament...Averaged 25.3 minutes and 13.0 points per game

**2014:** Second year playing on the Senior Women's National Team; averaging over 20 minutes in 8 exhibition games; averaged 6.3 Points per game and 3.3 rebounds per game in the Turkey exhibition tournament...averaged 6.7 points per game in the Czech exhibition tournament...Started in all 7 games at FIBA Worlds averaging 6.9 points, 1.6 rebounds and 1.1 assists per game.

**2013:** First year playing on the Senior Women's National team and competing in all exhibition tournaments and games leading up to FIBA Americas as well as playing in all FIBA America games. Averaged 10 points, 24.67 minutes and 2.50 assists per game in the FIBA Americas tournament and helped solidify Canada's spot in the 2014 FIBA Worlds Tournament.

**2012:** Member of the 2012 CWNT that competed at the FIBA U17 World Championships in Amsterdam where they won bronze...was the team leader and 6<sup>th</sup> overall in the tournament in points per game and ...one of the team captains. Member of the 3x3 Team that participated at the 2012 3x3 Youth World Championships held in Spain.

**2011:** Member of the 2011 U16 Cadette National Team that took part in the U16 FIBA Americas Championships held in Merida, Mexico, placing 3<sup>rd</sup>

### PROFESSIONAL HIGHLIGHTS:

**2020:** Nurse played in 21 games for the New York Liberty in the WNBA bubble in Florida, averaging 11.6 points, 2.6 rebounds, 2.0 assists, and 27.5 minutes per game.

**2019-20:** Kia played in 26 games this season with the Capitals, averaging 37.1 minutes, 20.9 points and 4.3 rebounds per year. She led her team to win the league championships and was named league MVP for her outstanding play.

**2019:** The second-year guard started all 34 games played with New York Liberty. She has accomplished new career highs by averaging 29.4 minutes per game, 13.7 points per game, and an 87.2 FT percentage. Named as one of the starting guards at the WNBA all-star game in Vegas.

**2018-19:** Kia played in 26 games with the UC Capitals in the WNBA offseason...Averaged 34.5 minutes, 18.4 points, 4.9 rebounds, and 2.1 assists per game...Won Australian WNBL Regular Season... Became Australian WNBL Champion with UC Capitals... Named WNBL Player of the Week Rd. 12.

**2018:** Kia had an outstanding rookie season with the New York Liberty. She played 34 games and averaged 22.8 minutes per game, 9.1 points per game and 2.4 rebounds per game. Nurse set the franchise record for most points in a game by a Liberty rookie and the most points in a game by a reserve player.
