## NATIONAL TEAM HIGHLIGHTS:

2018: At the Edmonton Grads International Classic, Fields contributed 19 points, 5 steals and 7 rebounds in the two games played. During the France Exhibition Tournament, Nirra played in all three games averaging 22.3 minutes per game...she also scored 23 points throughout the tournament. Nirra averaged 19 minutes per game and had a total of 34 points and 7 steals throughout the 2018 Women's World Cup in Tenerife, Spain where Team Canada finished in $7^{\text {th }}$ place.

2017: With her first trip of the year with the Senior National Team, she put up impressive numbers in China; including playing 131 total minutes, averaging 21.8 minutes per game, and scoring on average 13.1 points per game. While representing Canada with the Senior team at the FIBA Women's AmeriCup, she posted impressive numbers averaging 14.5 points per game, and 21.5 minutes per game. She helped Canada claim a Gold Medal at the event, while also being listed as the $3^{\text {rd }}$ highest points per game average across all teams. She was named to the all-star team as well as the MVP of the tournament.

2016: Member of the Rio 2016 Olympic team who placed $7^{\text {th }}$ in the tournament; averaged 12.1 minutes, 1.8 rebounds and 5.7 points per game. Played 3 exhibition games in the Edmonton Grads International Classic, averaging 12.3 points per game and 21 minutes. Played 3 games in the USA Showcase tournament, averaging 14.3 minutes per game and 5.3 points.

2015: Member of the 2015 Pan American Games team that won Canada's first ever gold medal. Played in two exhibition games in Spain. Played in three exhibition games in France. Helped the SWNT achieve gold at the FIBA Americas, qualifying for Rio 2016 Olympics.... Averaged 16.5 minutes per game and averaged 6.8 points.

2014: Participated in 8 exhibition games with the Senior Women's National team; averaged over 12 minutes per game in all exhibition appearances and 6.7 points per game and 2.7 rebounds per game in the Czech Exhibition Tournament...Appeared in all 7 games for Canada at FIBA Worlds averaging 5.7 points and 2.6 rebounds per game

2013: Member of the 2013Senior Women's National Team and participated in the exhibition tournament in China. She averaged 14.63 minutes, 4.50 points and 1.50 rebounds per game.

2011: Member of the 2011 Junior Women's National Team and participated in the 2011 FIBA World Championship U19 for Women in Puerto Montt, Chile. She averaged 24.2 minutes, 5.4 rebounds, 2.1 steals and 15.8 points per game...was $5^{\text {th }}$ overall for points per game, along with $3^{\text {rd }}$ overall for total points scored through the tournament. She was top 10 in the tournament for steals/game

2010: Member of the Canadian U17 Cadette Women's team and participated in the 2010 FIBA U17 Worlds Championship for Women ... She averaged 32.14 minutes, 22.4 points 6.9 rebounds per game ... Ranked $1^{\text {st }}$ in the tournament in points per game, $2^{\text {nd }}$ in total scoring, top 10 in field goal\% and $2^{\text {nd }}$ in minutes ... Led the team in scoring and steals and tied for $2^{\text {nd }}$ in rebounds, $2^{\text {nd }}$ in assists, top5 in $2 \mathrm{pt} \%$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ in blocked shots.. During the ESTADISTICAS DEL PARTIDO Exhibition tournament she averaged 27.11 minutes, 17 points and 3 rebounds per game.
