NATIONAL TEAM HIGHLIGHTS:

2020: Member of the FIBA Olympic Qualifying Tournament team that went 3-0 and secured Canada's third consecutive Olympic appearance. Scott Averaged 10 minutes and was 100% from the free throw line during the tournament.

2019: Scott was selected for the Senior Phase 1 Team participating in the Belgium Tournament and Great Britain Exhibition. In 1 game she played 29 minutes, scored 12 points, and recorded 12 rebounds. Due to injury, Scott was unable to participate in the rest of Phase 1 competition. Jamie played in all 4 games at the Pan American Games averaging 26.1 minutes, 11 points, 5.8 rebounds, and 1.8 assists per game. Scott started all 6 games played in the FIBA AmeriCup where their team claimed second place. She averaged 26.1 minutes, 12.8 points, and 5.7 rebounds per game. Scott competed in the FIBA Olympic Prequalifying Tournament where she averaged 19.6 minutes, 10.3 points, and 3.3 rebounds per game.

2018: At the Edmonton Grads International Classic, Scott contributed 9.0 points per game, 7.5 rebounds per game and 1.0 assists per game in her fourth year with the Senior Women's National Team. In France, Scott contributed 42 minutes and 14 points through the 3 exhibition games she played in. During, the World Cup Jamie contributed a total of 17 points throughout the tournament where Team Canada finished in 7th place.

2017: Jamie travelled with the Senior National Team to Europe for an exhibition tournament in which she played in all 5 games, averaging 19.8 minutes per game and 6.2 points per game. She then travelled again with the Senior team for an exhibition team tournament in China where she averaged 20.6 minutes per game, 8.6 points per game and 2.8 rebounds per game. Representing Canada at the 2017 FIBA Women's AmeriCup, where she contributed significantly to help the team win a Gold Medal at the event. While here she posted impressive numbers that aided in the overall success, averaging 15.2 minutes per game, 4.2 rebounds per game and 7.7 points per game.

2015: Played two exhibition games in Spain with the Senior Women's National Team. Member of the Development National Team that played six exhibition games in China...averaged 20 minutes and 12.4 points per game

2014: Member of the Development Women's National Team who placed 1st in the 35th Jones Cup, in Taipei Taiwan...averaged 28.1 minutes, 6.6 rebounds, 2.0 assists, and 10.8 points per game...3rd in the tournament for 3-pt shooting percentage...3rd for total 3-pts made...5th for total defensive rebounds.

2013: Member of the 2013 JWNT that competed at the FIBA U19 World Championships in Lithuania, finishing 7th...3rd in points per game with 17... Scored a tournament high 33 points in a game vs. the Netherlands. Named to FIBA All-World All Star team at the 2013 U19 FIBA World Championships.

PROFESSIONAL HIGHLIGHTS:

2019-20: In her second season with Dynamo, Jamie appeared in 30 games, averaging 30.3 minutes, 17.3 points, 3.0 assists and 5.9 rebounds per game between the PBL and EWBL. Named to the Eurobasket.com All-Russian PBL 3rd team SF for her play throughout the season. Jamie was also named Eurobasket.com All-EWBL Forward of the Year and All-EWBL Import of the Year, and named to the Eurobasket.com All-EWBL 1st team and EWBL All-Imports Team.

2018-19: Jamie averaged 31.8 minutes, 19.3 points, and 6.0 rebounds in 18 games playing for Dynamo Novosibirsk Region.

2017-18: Jamie was the All-Spanish LFB Guard of the Year, was named to the All-Spanish LFB 1st Team, the Spanish LFB All-Imports Team and played in the Spanish LFB Semifinals. She played 30 games and averaged 30 minutes, 15.4 points and 5.1 rebounds per game.

2017: Jamie played 3 games with the Flying Foxes in Austria. She played a total of 95 minutes, averaging 31.7 per game, tallying an average of 16 points per game and 7 rebounds.

2016: Made her professional debut in the WNBA with the Washington Mystics, averaging 1.7 points per game.
