# **NATIONAL TEAM HIGHLIGHTS:**

**2020:** Member of the FIBA Olympic Qualifying Tournament team that went 3-0 and secured Canada's third consecutive Olympic appearance. Achonwa averaged 13.3 points and 6.33 rebounds over 62:40 minutes during the OQT in Belgium. Natalie was named to the Tournament All-Star Five.

**2019:** Natalie competed in the FIBA Olympic Prequalifying Tournament where she averaged 19.8 minutes, 9.3 points, and 7.0 rebounds per game.

**2018:** Natalie joined Team Canada for the final phase following the WNBA season. Natalie averaged 21.8 minutes, 8 points, and 5 rebounds per game in the 2018 Women's World Cup in Tenerife, Spain where Team Canada finished in 7<sup>th</sup> place.

**2016:** Member of the Rio 2016 Olympic team who finished 7<sup>th</sup>, played in 6 games, averaging 11.4 minutes and 5 points. Played 3 games with the Senior National Team in the USA Showcase tournament, averaging 5.6 points per game and 13.4 minutes.

**2015:** Natalie received WNBA's rookie of the month for June...She was a Member of the 2015 Pan American Games team that won Canada's first ever gold medal...Averaged 8.75 points in 14.3 minutes per game, finished top ten in free throws for the tournament. Helped the SWNT achieve gold at the FIBA Americas, qualifying for Rio 2016 Olympics....Averaged 15.2 min and 10 points per game.

2013: Helped the SWNT qualify for FIBA Worlds 2014 by averaging 7.5 points and 6 minutes per game.

**2012:** Helped the SWNT to qualify for the Olympics averaging 3.6 points and 8 minutes per game...Member of the 2012 Olympic team that qualified for the quarter-finals in London, averaging 7.2 points and 19 minutes per game

**2010:** Averaged 12.6 minutes, 4.63 points and 4.1 rebounds per game during the Women's World Championships in Czech Republic...Ranked top 7<sup>th</sup> in the tournament in double-doubles... Top 4<sup>th</sup> in the team in scoring and 3<sup>rd</sup> in rebounds in the tournament

**2009:** Saw her first action with the SWNT as a 16-year-old... Averaged 6.6 points per game while playing on 13.8 minutes per game during the FIBA Americas Championship in Brazil in September... Shot .412 from the field and .500 from 3-pt range during that tournament... Also contributed 4.2 rebounds per game, good enough for fourth on the team...3<sup>rd</sup> team all-star at FIBA U19 World Championships.

**2009:** Fourth place finish at the 2009 FIBA World Championships where she was second on the team in points-per-game, and third in rebounds.

2008: Won a silver medal at 2008 FIBA Americas Championship tournament...Third on team in total rebounds for the tournament (29).

# PROFESSIONAL HIGHLIGHTS:

**2020:** Achonwa played in 18 games for the Indiana Fever in the WNBA bubble in Florida. Starting 11 games, Achonwa averaged 5.5 rebounds per game and 7.8 points per game.

**2019-20:** In her first season with Bourges, Achonwa appeared in 16 games between France's LFB league and Euroleague, playing 18.9 minutes per game. Averaging 10.9 points, 5.0 rebounds and capitalizing on 33 out of 44 free throws throughout the season. She was awarded Player of the Week among Canadians playing abroad in February.

**2019:** The fifth-year center played 30 games and started 18 with the Indiana Fever and averaged 21.1 minutes, 8.7 points, and a career-best FT percentage of 90.9

**2018-19:** Achonwa played in 25 games with the Jiangsu Phoenix of the WCBA, recording 25.2ppg, 11.1 rebounds per game, 28.7 minutes per game, and 58.1 FG percentage... Awarded Chinese WCBA Player of the Week 8 times...
