NATIONAL TEAM HIGHLIGHTS:

2022: Member of the 2022 U23 Canadian Team that placed first at the inaugural Globl Jam tournament. Pellington averaged 8.4 points, 2.6 rebounds and 3.2 assists per game.

2021: Pellington lead Canada in scoring at AmeriCup with 12.5 points per game, while also adding 2.5 rebounds and assists. She was later that summer named to her first Olympic roster, becoming a member of Team Canada at the 2021 Tokyo Olympics.

2020: Member of the FIBA Olympic Qualifying Tournament team that went 3-0 and secured Canada's third consecutive Olympic appearance. Pellington averaged 6.7 points, 3.7 rebounds and was .833 from the free throw line during the OQT in Belgium.

2019: Played in all 5 games of the Senior Team Phase 1. Pellington averaged 14.7 minutes, 5 points, and 1.7 assists per game in the Belgium Tournament, and 10.5 points, 1.5 rebounds, and 2.5 assists per game in the Great Britain Exhibition. Shaina played in all 4 games at the Pan American Games, averaging 25.5 minutes, 16 points, 7 rebounds, and 2 assists per game. Pellington competed in the FIBA Olympic Prequalifying tournament where she averaged 16.7 minutes, 10 points, and 3.7 assists per game.

2018: Pellington played two games at the Edmonton Grads International Classic where she contributed 2.5 assists per game and 1.0 rebounds per game.

2017: Member of the JWNT that placed 3rd at the U19 FIBA World Cup. Played in 3 exhibition games, averaging 19.6 minutes per game and 4.7 points per game. Played in 6 World Cup games averaging 24.6 minutes per game, 4.2 rebounds per game and 4.6 points per game.

2016: Member of the Cadette National Team who placed 7th at FIBA U17 World Championships in Zaragoza, Spain. Played in 3 exhibition games in Spain, averaged 6.3 points per game and 3 rebounds per game. Played 6 games at Worlds averaging 23 minutes and 8.5 points per game, ranked 3rd on Team Canada in assists per game.

SENIOR (2021-22): In her second season with the Wildcats, Pellington averaged 24.1 minutes a game and boosted her game averaged to 11.3 points, 2.5 rebounds and 2.4 assists. All three of Shaina's shooting percentages increased from her first year with Arizona.

JUNIOR (2020-21): In her junior season, Arizona reached the NCAA National Championship Game. Pellington made appearances in all 27 games averaging 15.5 minutes, 5.8 points and 1.9 rebounds per game.

SOPHOMORE (2018-19): In her sophomore season, Pellington made appearances in 23 games, starting in 12... Averaged 23.2 minutes, 13.0 points, 3.6 rebounds, and 2.8 assists per game.

FRESHMAN (2017-18): In her freshman season with Oklahoma, she played in 31 games and started 20... Averaged 27.3 minutes, 13.1 points, 2.2 assists and 2.7 rebounds per game... Ranked second nationally amongst Division 1 freshman in field goal percentage... Big 12 Freshman of the Year... Unanimously voted to the Big 12 All-Freshman Team... Received an All-Big 12 Honorable Mention.
